NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN of the cancellation of the 2nd and 3rd Day of the Non Statutory Public Inquiry (Wednesday 15th May and Thursday 16th May 2013) held at City Hall, College Green, Bristol BS1 5TR in relation to an the application to register the land described in the Schedule below as a Town or Village Green (“the application land”).

Subject to an Agreement between the Applicant, and the Objector (“the Agreement”), the Applicant has applied to amend the application to register a smaller area of the application land and the Objector has withdrawn its objection in respect of the proposed amended area.

The Commons Registration Authority will proceed to determine whether to accept the amendment and whether to register the proposed amended area as a Town or Village Green.
