Allocation Statement for Bridge Learning Campus - September 2024

As Bridge Learning Campus was oversubscribed, the criteria stated in their published admissions policy available on the Academy and Local Authority websites have been applied to allocate the places that are available at the Academy.

90 on-time applications (61 x 1st preferences, 13 x 2nd preferences, 16 x 3rd preferences have been received for Bridge Learning Campus, which has an Admission Number of 60.

1 place is required for a child with the Academy named in their Education, Health and Care Plan. This left 59 places to allocate using the published admissions criteria.

How the Initial Allocation of Places was made

The 59 places have been offered to the following children:

- 1. Children in the care of the Local Authority or who were previously in Care but immediately after being in Care became subject to an adoption order, child arrangement order or special guardianship order. (0 places)
- 2. Those children with siblings already at Bridge Learning Campus and who will still be there in September 2024. (20 places)
- 3. Those children with siblings already at New Fosseway School and who will still be there in September 2024. (0 places)
- 4. Those children living closest to Bridge Learning Campus as measured in a direct line from the home address to the Academy. (39 places)

The furthest distance offered a place in this category was 0.938 km.

Infant class size prejudice appeals - effects of infant class size legislation.

Appeals for Bridge Learning Campus will be heard on the basis of infant class size prejudice as the Academy will have two Reception classes each containing 30 pupils. Guidance on infant class size prejudice appeals is available on the school admissions website.
