



September 2024 first round allocation statement for Cathedral Primary School

As Cathedral Primary School is oversubscribed, the admissions criteria published on the School and Local Authority website have been applied to allocate the places that are available at the school.

Number of applications received

207 on-time applications (88 first preferences, 59 second preferences and 60 third preferences) have been received for Cathedral Primary School which has a published admission number of 60.

Two places are required for children with the school named in their Education, Health and Care Plan. There are 58 places to allocate using the published criteria.

How the initial allocation of places was made

The 58 places have been offered to the following children:

1. Those children who are defined as looked after children and children who were previously looked after but immediately after being looked after became subject to adoption, a child arrangements order, or special guardianship order. (None)
2. Those children with a sibling on roll at Cathedral Primary School. (26 places)
3. Those children who are a son/daughter of a member of staff at Cathedral Primary School. (None)
4. Those children who live within the Bristol local authority postcode areas BS1 to BS16 and have been randomly allocated. (32 places)
5. Those children who live outside the Bristol local authority postcode areas BS1 to BS16. (None)
