

NOTICE OF REFERENDUM

Bristol City Council

Referendum on how Bristol City Council is run

1. A referendum will be held on Thursday 5th May 2022 to decide on the question below:

How would you like Bristol City Council to be run?

By a Mayor who is elected by voters. This is how the Council is run now.

Or

By one or more Committees made up of elected Councillors. This would be a change from how the Council is run now.

2. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 12 midnight on Thursday, 14th April 2022. Applications can be made online: <https://www.gov.uk/register-to-vote>.
3. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes and amendments or cancellations of proxy votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at 5th Floor, B Bond Warehouse, Smeaton Road, Bristol, BS1 6XN by 5 pm on Tuesday, 19th April 2022.
4. New applications to vote by proxy at this referendum must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at 5th Floor, B Bond Warehouse, Smeaton Road, Bristol, BS1 6XN by 5 pm on Tuesday, 26th April 2022.
5. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this referendum on grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at 5th Floor, B Bond Warehouse, Smeaton Road, Bristol, BS1 6XN by 5 pm on Thursday, 5th May 2022. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5 pm on Tuesday, 26th April 2022. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5 pm on Tuesday, 26th April 2022
