Example Search

Let's find out what has been written about James Bond in the last week. Type "James Bond" in the search box, and choose the timeframe "past 7 days". Click on Search.

Other Search Options

- You can search just the national press by clicking on the interactive map, or by selecting the National England link below the map. This will bring up a list of titles, and you can select as many or as few as you wish.
- You can do the same with local, or International newspapers, if they are available.
- Advanced search allows you to combine more search strings.
- You can narrow your search to specific areas of the article e.g. All text, Headline, First paragraph or author/by-line.

Other Features

- Create Custom Lists of your favourite newspapers.
- Review all your searches and look at your saved articles in the folders on the left side of the screen.
- Articles usually appear on the date of publication. The archive stretches as far back as 1985 for the Times, though 1996-1998 is more usual.
