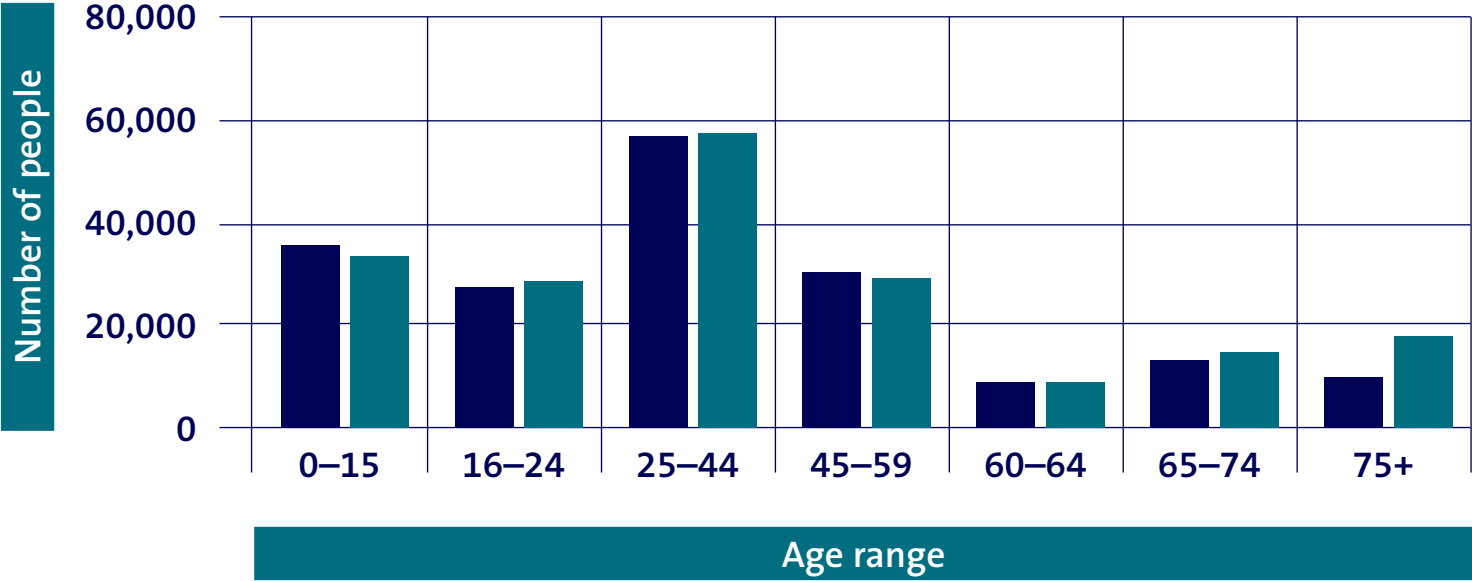

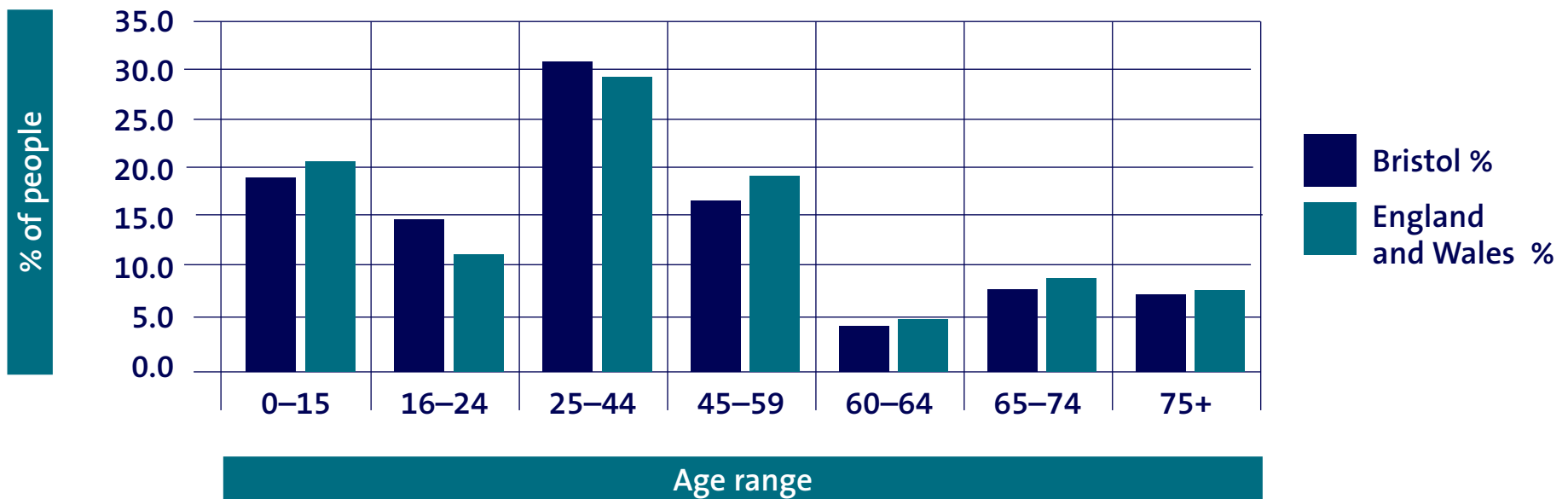

Population by age

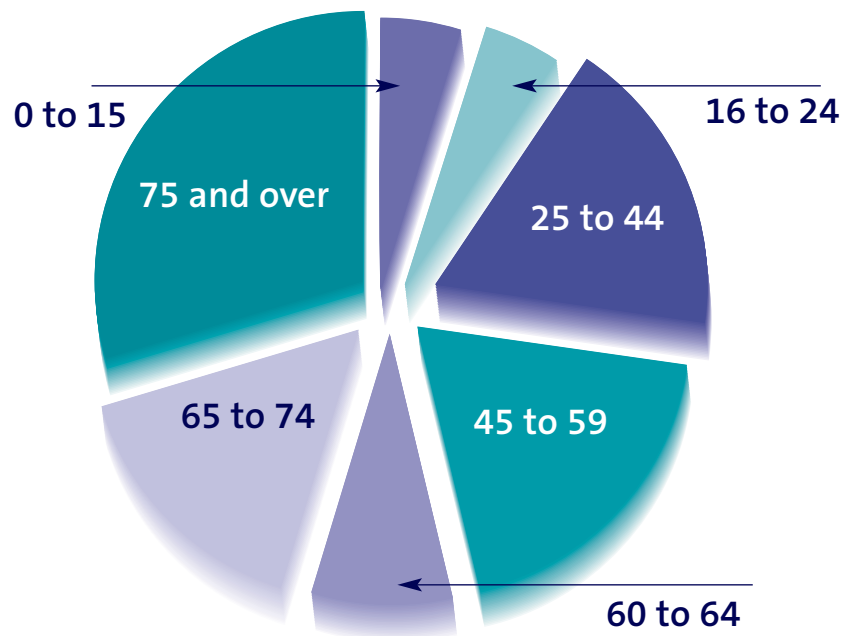

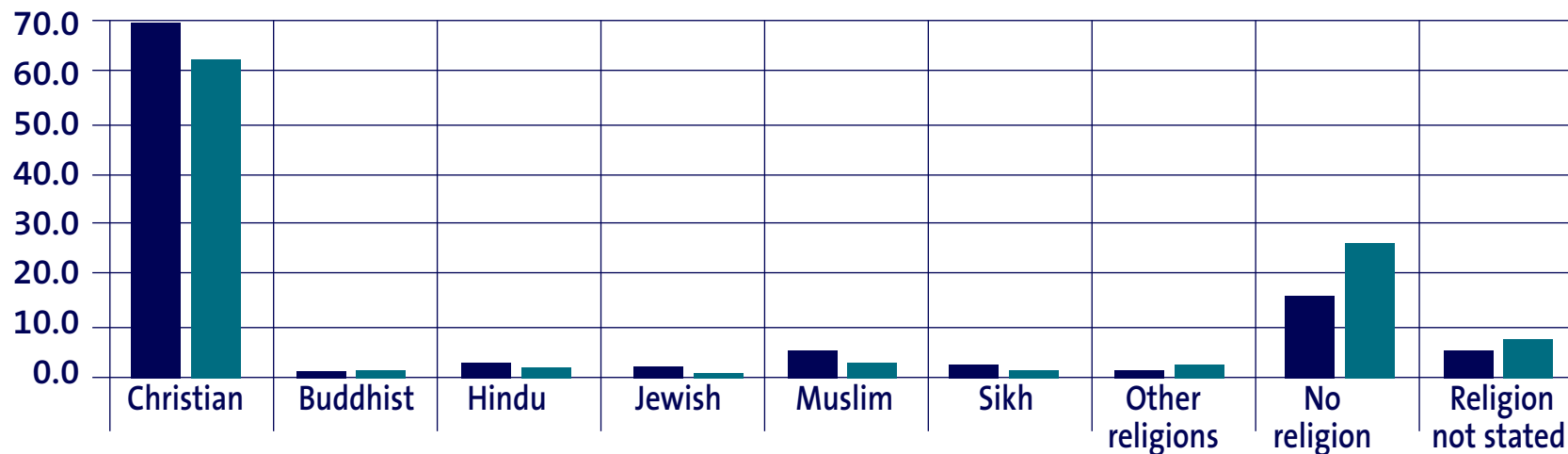

Bristol has a higher percentage of people with no religion – 24.5% compared to the national average of 14.8%



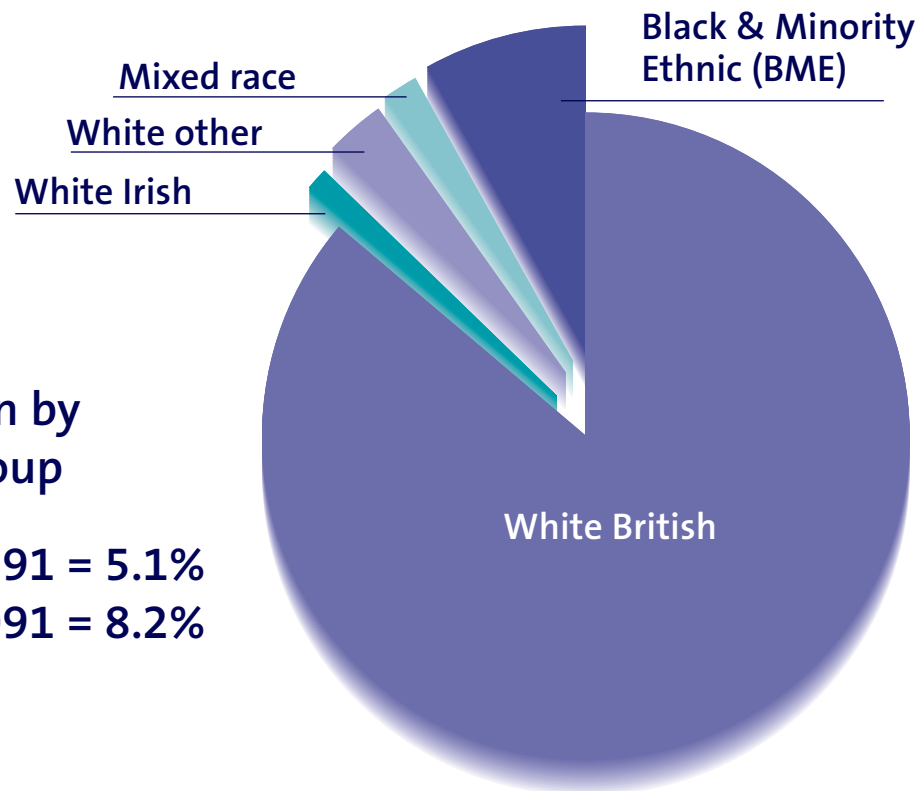
Population by Religion

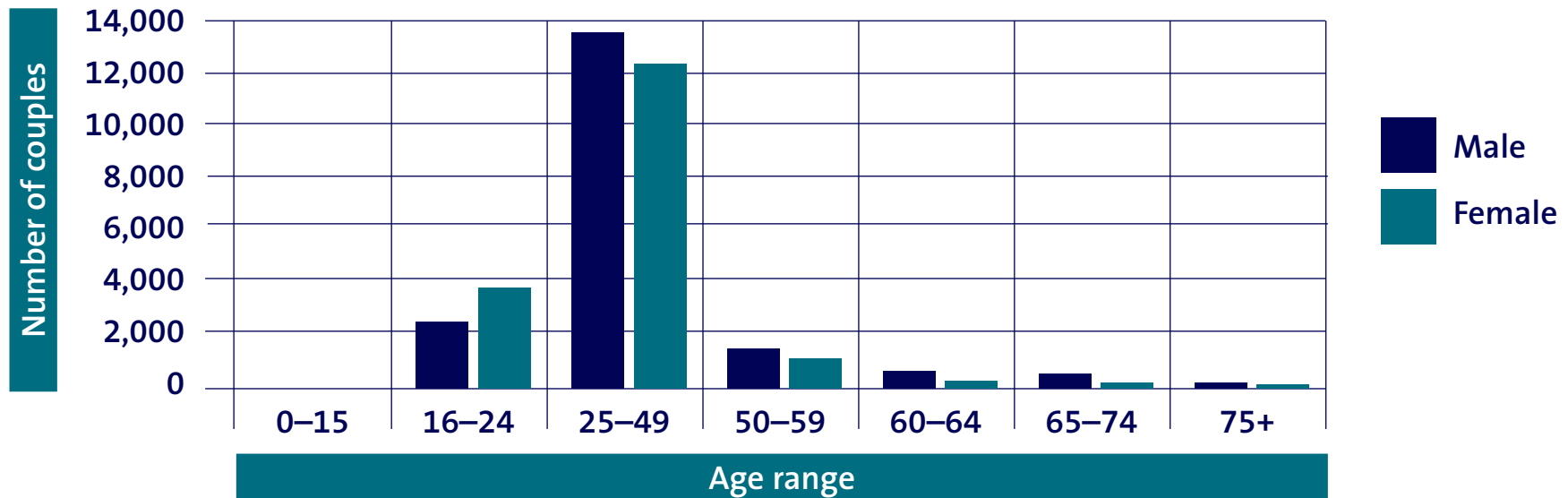

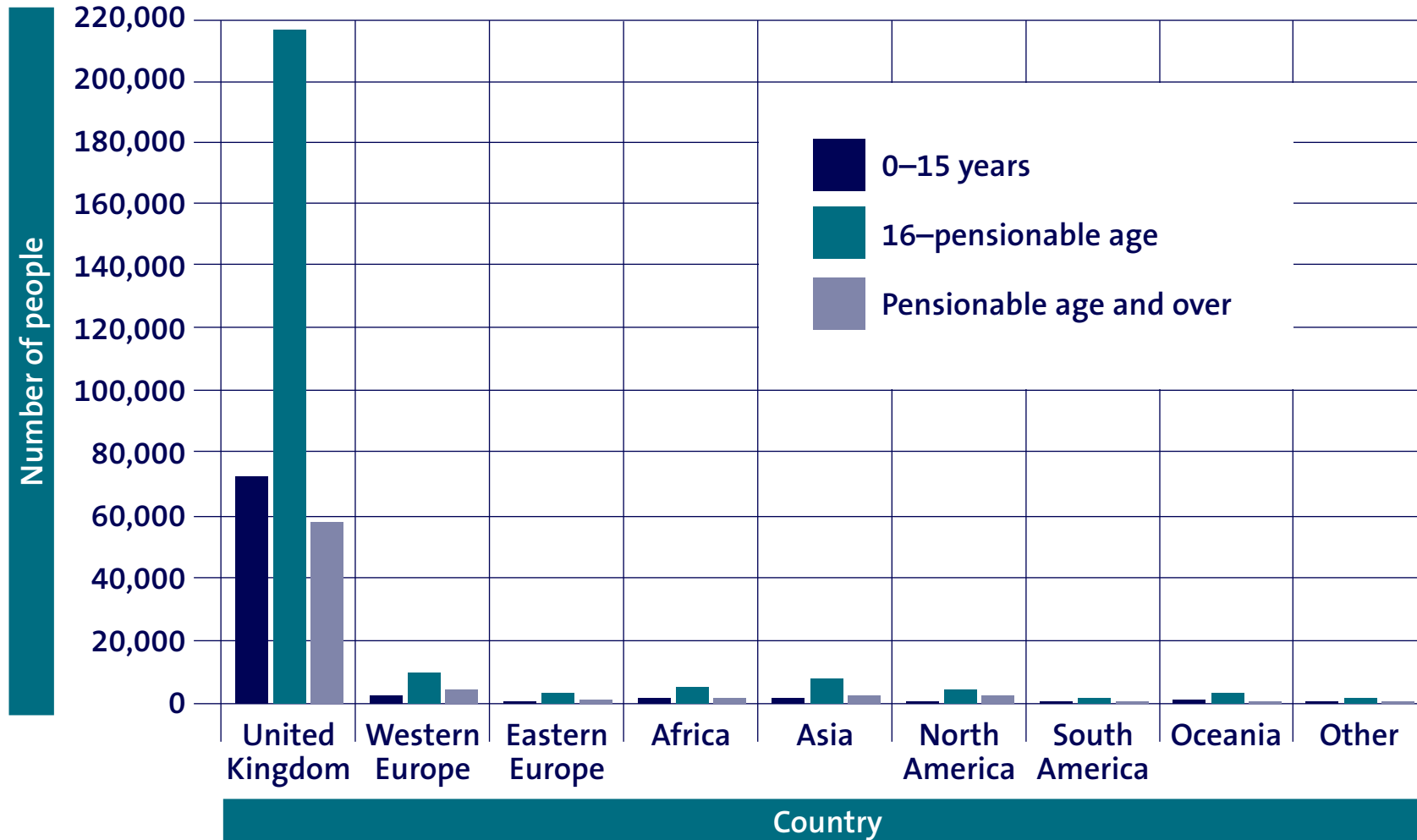

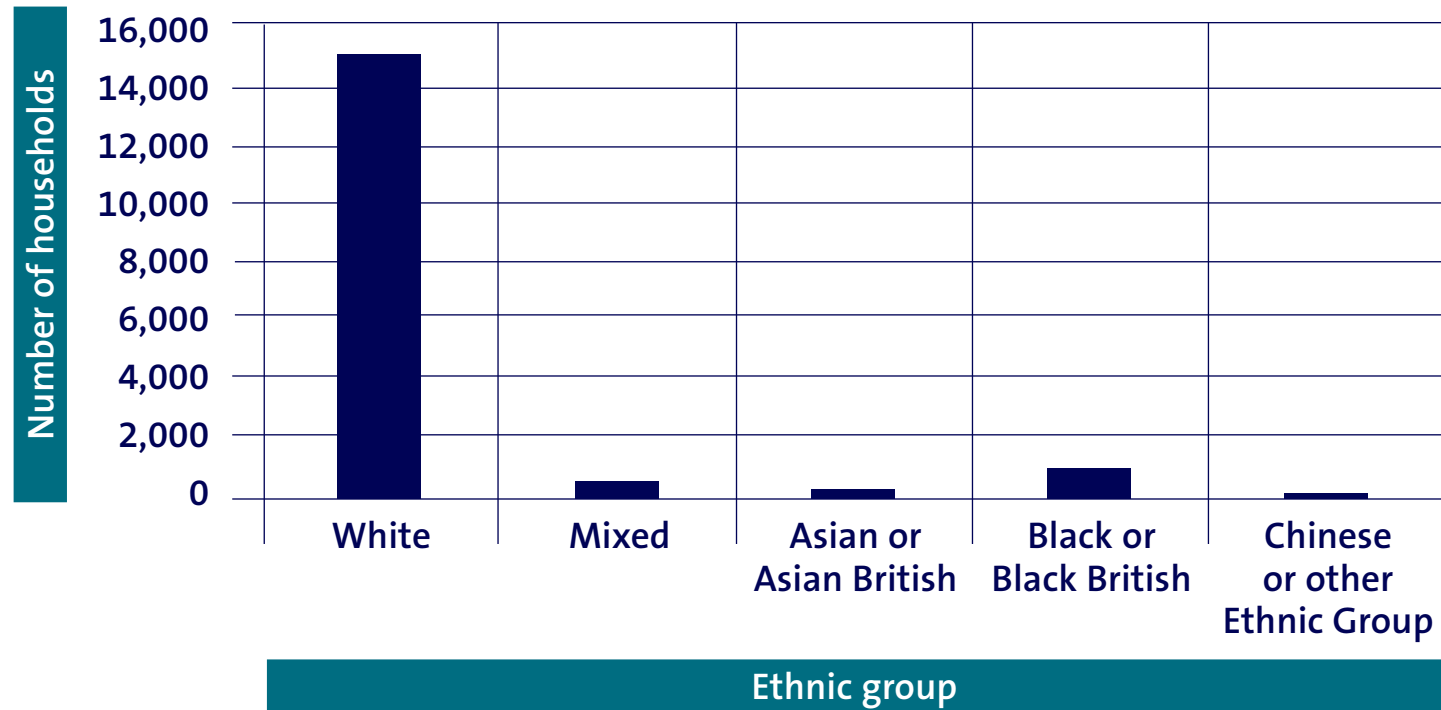
