



List of 1997 Adopted Local Plan Policies still saved following adoption of the Core Strategy (June 2011)

Bristol City Council adopted the Core Strategy on 21 June 2011. From adoption, some of the policies of the 1997 Adopted Bristol Local Plan that were previously “saved” for future use have now fallen away. However, 86 Local Plan policies remain saved pending the production further development plan documents.
