BRISTOL CITY COUNCIL EVENTS IN THE CITY DOCKS LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS NO 1-24/2011

1/11 BALTIC WHARF SAILING CLUB – BOB EVANS MEMORIAL TROPHY RACES SATURDAY 1st JANUARY 2011, 1100 - 1600 HRS

This event involves dinghy racing with a large number of sailing craft racing in the Baltic Wharf area. Mariners should proceed at a slow speed and navigate with caution in this area.

2/11 BRISTOL ROWING CLUB – HEAD OF THE HARBOUR ROWING RACES – TOTTERDOWN BASIN TO BALTIC WHARF, SUNDAY 20th FEBRUARY 2011, 1100 - 1600 HRS

This event will take place between Totterdown Basin and Baltic Wharf, with disabled races between Prince Street Bridge and Baltic Wharf and consists of a number of sculls and rowing eights in succession. Craft should proceed with caution and keep a good lookout for those participating in the race. Marshals will be stationed at all bridges to warn of oncoming participants. Craft wishing to proceed upstream of Prince St Bridge or from Totterdown Basin downstream will be stopped to allow the race to take place safely. Each race will last approximately 20 minutes.

3/11 BALTIC WHARF SAILING CLUB – HEAD OF THE HARBOUR SAILING RACES – BALTIC WHARF TO PRINCE STREET BRIDGE, SATURDAY 26th FEBRUARY 2011, 1300 - 1600 HRS

This event involves dinghy racing with a large number of sailing craft racing between Baltic Wharf and Prince St Bridge. Mariners should navigate with caution.

4/11 CLASSIC AND VINTAGE DINGHY RACING – BALTIC WHARF TO PRINCE STREET BRIDGE SATURDAY 16th APRIL 2011, 1030 - 1630 HRS

This event involves Vintage sailing dinghies racing between Baltic Wharf and Prince St Bridge. Mariners should navigate with caution.

5/11 AVON SCOUTS OPENING OF NEW YARD AND REGATTA SATURDAY 7th MAY 2011, 1000 - 1600 HRS

This event is to celebrate the opening of a New Scout Yard near the Nova Scotia by Chief Scout Bear Grylls. Water events taking place between Nova Scotia and Lloyds Amphitheatre. Mariners should navigate with caution.

6/11 VARSITY ROWING REGATTA – BALTIC WHARF TO CANONS MARSH SATURDAY 14th MAY 2011, 1000 - 1800 HRS

This event will take place between Baltic Wharf and the Lloyds Amphitheatre, Canons Marsh. A course will be laid on the north side of the harbour marked by red buoys along the entire length of the course. All vessels navigating in this area are requested to keep to the south side of the red buoys and navigate at a slow speed with caution.

7/11 10K MINI MARATHON – SUNDAY 15th MAY 2011

This event takes place around the Harbour area and several road closures will be in place preventing vehicular access to the Harbour. Prince St Bridge will not be swung until 1330 hrs. Mariners should contact the Harbour Office to arrange this swing if required.

- 8/11 TS ADVENTURE AVON DISTRICT SAILING REGATTA – BALTIC WHARF**
SUNDAY 5th JUNE 2011, 1000 - 1630 HRS
This event will involve a number of sailing craft taking part in races at Baltic Wharf. Mariners are requested to proceed at a slow speed and navigate with caution in this area.
- 9/11 WESSA YOUNG PERSONS SAILING DAY – BALTIC WHARF**
SATURDAY 11th JUNE 2011, 0900 - 1600 HRS
This event involves young novice persons sailing dinghies in the Baltic Wharf area. Mariners are requested to proceed at a very slow speed and navigate with caution in this area.
- 10/11 ROTARY CLUB CHARITY DRAGON BOAT RACE – BALTIC WHARF**
SUNDAY 12th JUNE 2011, 1000 - 1700 HRS
This event will take place on the south side of the harbour at Baltic Wharf between the Cottage Inn and the Bristol Marina. It will consist of groups of Dragon boats racing in a 30 metre wide course marked by yellow buoys. Craft are requested to pass this course at slow speed with caution.
- 11/11 TS ADVENTURE AVON DISTRICT SEA CADETS PULLING BOAT REGATTA – BALTIC WHARF**
SUNDAY 26th JUNE 2011, 1000 - 1600 HRS
This event is organised by the TS Adventure Sea Cadet Unit and will consist of a number of young people taking part in pulling boats, racing and carrying out manoeuvres in the Baltic Wharf/Cumberland Basin area. Mariners should give due consideration to participating craft.
- 12/11 BALTIC WHARF SAILING CLUB REGATTA WEEKEND – BALTIC WHARF**
SATURDAY 2nd & SUNDAY 3rd JULY 2011, 1000 - 1700 HRS
This event will involve a large number of sailing dinghies taking part in races and fun events in the Baltic Wharf area. Mariners are requested to pass this area with due caution and avoid impeding those taking part in races.
- 13/11 TRI SERVICES CADET REGATTA – BALTIC WHARF**
SUNDAY 10th JULY 2011, 1000 - 1630 HRS
This event will consist of a number of small craft operated by young persons taking part in various manoeuvres and races in the Baltic Wharf area. Mariners are requested to proceed at a slow speed and navigate with caution.
- 14/11 SOUTH WEST AREA SEA CADET REGATTA – BALTIC WHARF TO SS GREAT BRITAIN**
SATURDAY 16th & SUNDAY 17th JULY 2011, 0830 - 1700 HRS
This event will consist of numerous pulling boats, sail boats, canoes and motorboats taking part in various races. A buoyed racing channel will be laid on the south side of the harbour. Mariners are requested to proceed at slow speed when passing through this area and navigate with caution.
- 15/11 BRISTOL HARBOUR FESTIVAL – FLOATING HARBOUR**
SATURDAY 30th JULY & SUNDAY 31st JULY 2011
Vessels entered for this event will be moored in the Floating Harbour on pontoons projecting from the quayside at Canons Marsh, St Augustine's Reach, Amphitheatre and Hanover Quay. Installation of these pontoons will commence 4 weeks prior to

the event and be dismantled within 4 weeks after the event. Vessels moored in these areas that are not entered for the event will be required to moor elsewhere as directed by the Harbour Master.

Aquatic events will take place in this area throughout the above period. Craft moored in this area should be prepared for some wash from these events and ensure their vessels are adequately fendered. Vessels passing through this area may be delayed for periods of up to 20 minutes whilst these events take place.

- 16/11 BRISTOL COMET SAILING OPEN MEETING – BALTIC WHARF**
SUNDAY 14th AUGUST 2011, 1000 - 1600 HRS
This event will involve a number of sailing craft taking part in races at Baltic Wharf. Mariners are requested to proceed at a slow speed and navigate with caution in this area.
- 17/11 BRISTOL HALF MARATHON – PRINCE STREET BRIDGE SWING RESTRICTION**
SUNDAY 11th SEPTEMBER 2011, 0830 - 1400 HRS
The route of the annual Bristol Half Marathon will encompass the Floating Harbour between Prince St. Bridge and Junction Lock Bridge. The race will commence at 0830 hrs and finish by 1400 hrs. During this time Prince St Bridge will not be swung for vessels. Mariners who may be disrupted by this restriction are advised to contact the Harbour Office to make alternative arrangements.
- 18/11 BALTIC WHARF SAILING CLUB OPEN MEETING FOR ACCESS BOATS - BALTIC WHARF**
SATURDAY 17th SEPTEMBER 2011, 1030 - 1700 HRS
This event will involve a number of sailing craft taking part in races at Baltic Wharf. Mariners are requested to proceed at a slow speed and navigate with caution in this area.
- 19/11 BRISTOL KAYAK REGATTA – BALTIC WHARF**
SUNDAY 18th SEPTEMBER 2011, 1000 - 1600 HRS
Numerous canoes will be carrying out, either marathon races, harbour circuits or sprint races in the Baltic Wharf area. Mariners are requested to proceed at a slow speed and navigate with caution.
- 20/11 CHARITY DRAGON BOAT RACE – BALTIC WHARF**
SUNDAY 25th SEPTEMBER 2011, 1000 - 1700 HRS
This event will take place on the south side of the harbour at Baltic Wharf between the Cottage Inn and the Bristol Marina. It will consist of groups of dragon boats racing in a 30 metre wide course marked by yellow buoys. Mariners are requested to proceed at a slow speed and navigate with caution when passing through the course.
- 21/11 VINTAGE DINGHY RACING – BALTIC WHARF TO PRINCE STREET BRIDGE**
SATURDAY 19th NOVEMBER 2011, 1030 - 1700 HRS
This event is a sailing dinghy race in the area between Baltic Wharf and Prince St Bridge involving a large number of sailing craft. Mariners are requested to proceed at a slow speed and navigate with caution.
