

# Walking for Health Bristol



## Volunteer Mini Bus Driver Task Description

### Description of role:

To pick up and drive walkers to and from walk locations not on a public transport route.

### Duties/responsibilities:

- To undertake MIDAS (volunteer mini bus driver) training.
- To ensure safe pick up, passage and drop off of passengers.
- Communicate with the walk leader/organiser as to pick up times and locations.
- To liaise with walk leaders and organisers regarding **road route** to walk start and **parking** at site - obtain and carry map with this information marked on.
- Communicate with the walk leader/organiser as to expected numbers on the bus going to and from the location. However, the driver should be allowed to focus on the safety of passengers using the bus and getting to and from the walk start. They should NOT be responsible for counting walker's on/off the bus or doing a walk register.
- Communicate with the walks organiser/transport booker as to whether any passengers have special needs (bolster seats required? accessible mini bus required?).
- Inform your walks coordinator and the bus hire company should any damage occur to the vehicle during hire period.
- Refill fuel as required according to rental organisations procedures.
- Adhere to hire organisations rental and health and safety procedures.
