## Lottery boost for Colliter's Brook

On Saturday, 16th February the Lord Mayor opened a "Rivers and Parks Conference" at the Southville Centre.

Workshops covered: ● Accessibility of Green Spaces, ● Green Spaces and Young People, ● Developing a Wildlife Network and ● Public Art.

During the conference it was announced that NET-WORK South Bristol has secured funding from the Heritage Lottery for a two-year project to do work with rivers and other green spaces in South Bristol.

The project will be working closely with Bristol Living Rivers and existing community organisations as well as setting up new groups on the Avon New Cut, the Malago-Pigeonhouse river catchments and Brislington and Colliters Brooks.

Funding has also been obtained for a part-time worker (based at the Create Centre) to work for the next two years on this 'Riverscape Project'.

The role has gone to Helen Adshead, who started her
