

ASHTON COURT ESTATE RECREATION CODES

Help ensure that Ashton Court can be enjoyed by a wide range of visitors by adhering to the following codes of conduct:

Cyclists & mountain bikers

Cycle safely, wear a helmet and use a bell as warning to others.

Watch out for walkers, horse riders and dogs and always be friendly.

Slow down and give way to others on shared drives, tracks and in car parks.

Please follow the Off Road Cycle Trail Code

- Keep to the trail to avoid damage to plants and wildlife
- Bike safely and respect others
- Expect the unexpected - and slow down
- Take all litter home and leave car parks tidy
- Come by bike or park at Leigh Woods car park

Dog walkers

Control your dog to ensure it does not scare or disturb wildlife, especially during the nesting season 1st March to July 31st. We all have a legal obligation to protect wildlife.

Watch out for cyclists and horse riders, always be friendly and keep your dog under control to avoid accidents with others.

Keep dogs on leads in the deer parks, picnic areas, cafes, courtyards, within 75m of car parks and across the golf course.

Bag and bin dog waste responsibly to avoid damage to natural habitats and health hazards to all.

Horse riders

Only use Church Lodge car park where the horse riding trail starts and please leave parking areas clean and tidy.

Keep to the horse trail or estate drives to prevent any damage to wildlife and plants.

Watch out for cyclists, walkers and dogs and always be friendly.

Galloping is not permitted. Cantering is permitted in designated areas (refer to map at start of trail).

Please avoid riding in the estate during especially wet periods.

Do not clean out horse trailers in the car park.
