Where can I park at Oldbury Court Estate?

Oldbury Court Estate car park can be found off Oldbury Court Road in Fishponds (BS16 2JH). For Snuff Mills you can park at the end of River View in Stapleton (BS16 1DL).

Do I have to pay for parking?

The car parks are all free.

Can I have a BBQ at Oldbury Court Estate?

Yes, however BBQ's are not allowed on the cricket square and we ask visitors to raise their BBQ's off the ground in order to avoid damage to plants and wildlife and not to use disposable BBQ's.

Can I walk my dog at Oldbury Court Estate?

Yes, except for the play area where dogs are not allowed.

For which age groups is the play area at Oldbury Court Estate suitable?

We would recommend the playground for children aged 0-13 years.

Are there any restrictions in the play area?

Yes, dogs are not allowed in the play area and smoking is prohibited.

Why is Oldbury Court Estate locally called Vassall's park?

The Vassall family held the estate until 1936 which is why the park is known locally as Vassall's park.
