TRYM VALLEY OPEN SPACE DRAFT PLANTING MAP

Legend

- English oak
- Fruit tree
- Silver birch
- Standard - black poplar, alder and willow
- Riparian woodland

This plan proposed to create several new areas of tree planting in Trym Valley Open Space. In the southern area of the park large standard trees will be planted with wire mesh guards.

A small orchard area of 16 trees will be planted leading to a 'Tiny Forest' planted in conjunction with Earthwatch.

Further upstream, the riparian woodland will be planted with small whips which grow well in wet conditions such as alder, willow and downy birch. The area of woodland will be planting with a mixture of native species.
