

Privacy Notice

Parking Services – Parking Permits

Bristol City Council is the data controller for the purposes of the Data Protection Act 1998 and other regulations including the General Data Protection Regulation (Regulation (EU) 2016/679), which means it determines what your data is used for and why it is collected. The purpose of this privacy notice is to tell you about what information we collect about you when you use our service, how we use that information and who we may share it with.

The contact details of the data controller are Bristol City Council – Parking Services

What data we need to collect and the legal basis for processing it:

To provide this service, we will process name, address, email address, telephone number, Unique Property Reference Number (UPRN), Council Tax & Business Rates customer reference numbers, vehicle registration details including but not limited to make, model and colour. Other data collected may include Blue Badge serial numbers. We are collecting this data because it is in the public interest to process this in order for Bristol City Council to fulfil its obligations as the Highway Authority and manage the use of the highway under Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and relevant Traffic Regulation Orders (TRO).

If you don't allow us to use your data this will mean that Bristol City Council cannot provide this service.

How long we will keep your data for:

We will/may hold this information for up to 6 years. After this, your information will be deleted or archived.

Why we need to collect your data:

We will use this information for the management and enforcement of the Residents Parking Scheme areas and permit parking areas in Off and On street parking areas as designated under the relevant Traffic Regulations Orders issued by Bristol City Council.

Who we share your data with and why:

This data will be shared with our Data Processor who is a third party supplier of the software used for the application, processing, issuing & management of approved permits.

Your rights as a data subject:

You have the right to ask for access to your data and where data is found to be inaccurate to have that data corrected. In certain circumstances you have the right to have data held about you erased, or the use of it restricted. You may be able to object to processing and may also have the right to have your data transferred to another data controller.



You also have a right of complaint to the Information Commissioner's Office (ICO) at www.ico.org.uk if you think we have not dealt with your information in a proper manner.

You can ask to see what information we hold about you and have access to it. You can do this by contacting:
