

Connecting Bristol newsletter

Bristol City Council (BCC) is the data controller for the purposes of the Data Protection Act 1998 and other relevant regulations. The purpose of this privacy policy is to tell you about what information we collect about you when you use our service, how we use that information and who we may share it with.

What data we need to collect and the legal basis for processing it:

We collect information, with your express consent, for the following purposes:

- We collect name, email address and organisation name (if applicable) in order to email Connecting Bristol newsletters to people and organisations who have requested to receive them. (Connecting Bristol newsletters provide information about innovation news and events);

We will only process this information with your express consent and only for the purpose(s) specified

How long we will keep your data for:

We will hold this information for up to three years from the date of consent. Before the three year period finishes, we will re-contact subscribers to confirm they wish to remain on our mailing list.

Who we share your data with and why:

This data will be disclosed to council officers in the City Innovation Team to enable Connecting Bristol newsletters to be sent to subscribers.

Personal information will not be published or passed on to third parties.

The information that you supply is collected using software called "Mailchimp".

"Mailchimp" stores data on secure servers;

If we have obtained your consent to use your data:

You are able to withdraw your consent for us to process your information at any time.

Your rights as a data subject:

You have the right to request access to your data and where data is found to be inaccurate to have that data corrected. You have the right to have data held about you erased, or the use of it restricted. You have the right to have your data transferred to another data controller.

You also have a right of complaint to the Information Commissioner's Office (ICO) at www.ico.org.uk if you think we have dealt with your information in an inappropriate manner.

You can ask to see what information we hold about you and have access to it. You can do this, by contacting:
