

# THE PROPOSED PLAN KNOWLE WEST

Key community involvement events to develop the proposed plan:

## **September 2009**

A community vision and 13 improvements (objectives) for Knowle West were agreed (see related documents on [bristol.gov.uk](http://bristol.gov.uk)) following community involvement with local people.

## **November 2009**

Ideas to consider the best places for improvements like: new employment locations, new education and community facilities, new housing, and better open green spaces were shown. These ideas were developed by local residents and stakeholders who worked together in a group called the Knowle West Team.

## **October 2010**

Comments from residents were developed further into proposals called the 'Knowle West Regeneration Plans'. Five options were presented to show how the area could be positively transformed based on different levels of investment. Plans also considered the agreed community Knowle West "Vision" and 13 improvements. We learnt:

- 84% supported major change in Knowle West
- residents wanted Filwood Broadway to be their main shopping centre
- most residents supported new transport links
- most supported building new homes and improving some of the older properties in the area.

## **2011**

Throughout last year we continued to work with local people to develop the ambitious proposed plan for Knowle West.

## **Study Tours**

There have also been a number of tours during the community involvement process to help develop the regeneration plans. Aimed at residents, officers and the project board, the purpose was to learn about other physical regeneration projects. There have been visits to the campus, Stonebridge estate and Upper Horfield.
