There will be an age verification gateway at the front of the company website that states laws on drinking age and responsibility.

Full address details including postcode must be given when placing an order.

There shall be a minimum order value of £15 for all sales including alcohol.

Records of all orders are to be retained for a period of 6 months and made available for inspection by a police officer or authorised officer.

All deliveries within Bristol are to be by the company's own staff, the staff must be appropriately trained.

Delivery of alcohol will be refused whereby the driver considers the person receiving the delivery to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs.

Any reference to alcohol delivery will not be shown in any advertising on delivery vehicles.

No deliveries to areas of open space.

If the recipient of a delivery of alcohol appears under 25 years of age, recognised photographic identification will be requested before any intoxicating liquor is handed over. Acceptable proof of age shall include identification bearing the customers photograph, date of birth and integral holographic mark or security measure. Suitable means of identification would include PASS approved proof of age card, photo-card driving licence and passport.

15 A noise limiting device shall be used in relation to all sound amplification equipment used in conjunction with the premises licence.

16 The noise limiting device shall be set at a level approved by the Council through its authorised environmental health officer.

17 The noise limiting device shall be reset by the Council through its authorised

environmental health officer, if deemed necessary.

18 The noise limiting device shall be properly secured so that it cannot be tampered with.

19 All live music shall be played through the in-house noise limiting device.
