The Local Authorities (Members Allowances)(England) Regulations 2003

(re: 2012 / 2013 financial year - 1 April 2012 - 31 March 2013)

In accordance with the Local Authorities (Members Allowances) (England) Regulations 2003 a scheme for determining the level of allowances that councillors and co-optees could receive during the 2012 / 2013 year was approved by the city council in accordance with recommendations made by an independent review panel.

For the financial year 2012 / 2013 the basic remuneration for all councillors was £11,416 per annum and for co-optees £571 per annum (both sums are deemed to cover the cost of any business travel within Bristol). In addition to the basic remuneration, a special responsibility allowance (SRA) is paid to some councillors to reflect their special responsibilities over and above their role as ward councillor/co-optee.

Details of the sums paid to councillors and co-optees during the financial year 2012 / 13 are set out below:

- SRA - Special Responsibility Allowance (e.g. Committee Chair, Executive Member, Political Group Leader, including service on Appeals Committee)
- DCA* - Dependant Carers' Allowance
- T&S - Travelling (outside Bristol) and Subsistence
- IT - Expenses for Broadband Connection and IT Equipment
