NOTICE is given that Bristol City Council is about to commence a review of polling districts, polling places and polling stations within the area of the local authority and the parliamentary constituencies of Bristol.

The review will include a comment by the Acting Returning Officer on proposed polling stations and the Council invites representations from electors within the above area.

Bristol City Council and the Acting Returning Officer would welcome representations and comments from any elector within Bristol or any person or organisation with expertise in access for persons with disabilities. Any person or organisation making such representations should give alternative places that may be used as polling places or polling stations.
