**(CENTRAL ZONE, ASHLEY, CENTRAL AND LAWRENCE HILL WARDS,
CITY OF BRISTOL) (CONTROLLED PARKING) ORDER 20--**

The City Council of Bristol hereby gives NOTICE that it proposes to make a traffic order, the effect of which would be:-

1. to introduce a loading place in **Nelson Street**;
2. to revise prohibition of waiting arrangements for vehicles in a length of **Nelson Street**;
3. to revise loading/unloading prohibition arrangements for vehicles in length of **Nelson Street**; and
4. to introduce prohibition of waiting on the footway arrangements for vehicles in a length of **Nelson Street**.

All other existing provisions in the Central Zone would be consolidated.
