### **Statement of Reasons**

---

**Road/Area: Romney Avenue Area, Lockleaze Ward**

**Proposal: Waiting Restriction Review**

---

The Council proposes to introduce a Traffic Regulation Order (TRO) for revised waiting restrictions in the Romney Avenue Area.

The review has been initiated in response to concerns expressed locally about inconsiderate and obstructive parking behaviour, which can interfere with the movement of vehicles and pedestrians, interrupt sightlines and create potentially unsafe highway conditions. To resolve these problems, it is proposed that waiting should be prohibited in the vicinity of junctions and vehicle accesses, around bends and in sections of road which are too narrow to accommodate parked vehicles without impeding the passage of traffic.

For information, a zebra crossing will also be introduced to the rear of Stoke Park Nursery and Primary School as part of this package. This has already been consulted on and approved. The waiting restrictions underlying the crossing will be kept as part of this TRO, however the crossing will take precedence.

It appears to the Council that it is expedient to make the order –

- For avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising;
- facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians);
