Appeals Timetable 2020-21

Appeals for St Joseph's Catholic Primary School are arranged by the Clifton Diocese Schools and Colleges Department which is independent of the school.

The Clerk to the independent appeal panel will ensure that:

- Appellants receive at least 10 schools days' notice of their appeal hearing.
- The appeal panel papers are sent to panel members and other parties involved at least 7 days before the confirmed date of the hearing.
- Decision letters are sent within five school days of the hearing wherever possible.

Reception Admission

On-Time Applicants:

16th April 2020: Letter of refusal sent by child's home Local Authority.

18th May 2020: Deadline for appeals to be lodged.

Evidence from the school and any additional evidence from appellants should be provided to the Clerk to the Council at least 8 days before the confirmed hearing date. The Appeal Panel will decide if it will consider any evidence provided less than 8 days in advance.

On or after 2nd July 2020 – Period for Appeals to be heard.

For late applications, appeals will be heard within 40 school days from the deadline for appeals being lodged where possible, or within 30 school days of the appeal being lodged.

All of the dates are intended (not confirmed) dates and are subject to change.

For applications for In-Year admissions, appeals will be heard within 30 school days of the appeal being lodged.
