

THE CITY AND COUNTY OF BRISTOL (CLIFTON)
(ONE WAY) (NO. 1) ORDER, 1968

The Council of the City and County of Bristol in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by Sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf, hereby make the following Order:-

1. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on any of the lengths of road specified in the first column of the Schedule to this Order otherwise than in the direction specified opposite to such length in the second column of the said Schedule.
2. The Interpretation Act, 1889 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. The City and County of Bristol (Princess Victoria Street) (One Way) Order 1962 is hereby revoked. (6203)
4. This Order shall come into operation on the 18th day of January 1968 and may be cited as "The City and County of Bristol(Clifton) (One Way) (No. 1) Order, 1968."

<u>Princess Victoria Street, Clifton from its junction with Regent Street to its junction with The Mall</u>	North-east to South-west
<u>The Mall, Clifton from Princess Victoria Street to its junction with Portland Street.</u>	South-east to North-west
<u>Waterloo Street, Clifton from Princess Victoria Street to Portland Street.</u>	South-east to North-west
