



## Summary of public comments on draft tree planting plan for

### Dorian Road Playing Field

November 2021



A draft tree planting plan was circulated to immediate neighbours and posted in numerous locations around the open space. Thank you to everyone for taking the time to comment. Below is a summary of the comments and enquiries received; Bristol City Council's response; and any minor revisions to the plan if appropriate.

#### Areas of concern raised:

We have given these concerns consideration and provide our responses with any action below.

#### Comments:

1. Could the informal footpaths be kept clear for continued use?
2. Could smaller species be considered to prevent the area becoming too dark/dense?

#### Bristol city council response:

1. Yes, we will ensure all desire lines remain. We will plant the trees at least 2m from the pathways to allow them to feel light an open.
2. Many smaller shrub species have been selected for this site such as Dogwood, Hazel and Viburnum.
