



COVID security outdoor trading

Due to the implications of the COVID 19 virus, Christmas trading may have to operate under COVID secure site measures. A decision will be made nearer to the time and in-line with the latest Government guidance.

We can anticipate certain changes if we do have to operate under these conditions as follows:

- Traders may be asked to bring their own equipment which will include a 3 x 3 metre gazebo (including suitable weights), inclusive of side-sheets and tables (all previously provided by the Markets & Estates Service in the form of market umbrellas and trestle tables x 2). **Your equipment must be safe and is your responsibility.**
- All traders to complete a COVID secure check-list
- All traders to provide hand gel for their own/customer use
- Regular cleaning down of high touch areas
- Quarantining any returned items for 72 hours i.e. those that can't be easily wiped down e.g. fabric items.
- Spit screens or equivalent in place
- Contactless payments to be encouraged where possible
- Appropriate PPE to be worn and safely disposed of
- Anyone showing symptoms of COVID should not attend the market and should contact the office without delay and at your earliest convenience – MarketsEstate@bristol.gov.uk
- Any staff to be informed of COVID safety procedures in place as per current Government guidance
- Signage to advise of current social distancing measures in place
- Queue management systems
- Any other changes as outlined by current Government guidance and the Markets & Estates Service

If your application is successful, you will also be asked to complete the 'check list' before commencing any trade. The adequate completion of this document is a pre-requisite for trading but if you have any questions, please ask via email MarketsEstate@bristol.gov.uk when completing your form.
