Relevant areas for Consultations

What are relevant areas?

Bristol City Council is required to determine the area that admission authorities in Bristol should use when consulting on school admission arrangements. We are required to review these areas every two years.

Admission authorities are required to consult with the Local Authority as well as admission authorities in their own place planning area.

Furthermore, they are required to consult with other persons in the relevant area who in the opinion of the admission authority have an interest in the proposed admissions.

Admission authorities must also consult with:

- Parents of children between the ages of two and eighteen
- Whichever of the governing body and the local authority who are not the admission authority
- Any adjoining neighbouring local authorities where the admission authority is the local authority
- in the case of schools designated with a religious character, the body or person representing the religion or religious denomination.

Schools are not restricted to these alone and should make the effort to reach as wide an audience possible.

Relevant areas for Bristol City Council Local Authority

For Bristol City Council, as an admissions authority, the relevant area being consulted on is the whole city (City of Bristol Local Authority area). Therefore, any consultation on amendments to the Local Authority's admission arrangements will be addressed to all Bristol schools and relevant admission authorities and interested persons in the whole of Bristol.

Relevant areas for Bristol primary schools

For primary academies and other own admission authority primary schools the relevant area will be the local area in which the school is located. Therefore, any consultation on amendments to primary school admission arrangements will be addressed to all schools and interested persons in that relevant area. Primary schools do not need to consult with secondary schools.

There are fourteen relevant areas for Bristol primary schools. These are:

- Eastville, Frome Vale and Hillfields
- St George and Easton
- Avonmouth and Lawrence Weston
- Bishopston and Ashley Down, Cotham and Redland

- Stoke Bishop and Westbury-on-Trym and Henleaze
- Horfield and Lockleaze
- Brislington
- Bishopsworth and Hartcliffe and Withywood
- Filwood, Knowle and Windmill Hill
- Bedminster and Southville
- Hengrove and Whitchurch and Stockwood

For own admission authority secondary schools, the relevant area will be the whole city (City of Bristol Local Authority area). Therefore, any consultation on amendments to secondary school admission arrangements will be addressed to all schools and interested persons in the whole of Bristol.
