

# Decision Notice: Tree removal and replacement



Site name: St Augustine's Parade

Number of trees: 1

Type of tree: Small-Leaved Lime

Date of notice: 22/09/2025

## Consultation Period:

Friday 15<sup>th</sup> August 2025 until Friday 12<sup>th</sup> September 2025.

## Outcome of public consultation:

Following consideration of all the comments the outcome is that the tree is to be removed.

## Reason for removal

Bristol City Council will be removing one Small-Leaved Lime Tree and replacing it with three new trees in new planters around the Canon's Road junction as part of wider works to refurbish and upgrade the junction.

The tree was planted in 2017 and now needs to be removed to accommodate a wider footway and cycle way between the City Centre and College Green.

Translocation of the tree to an alternative location will be explored during the works, but should it not be feasible due to the tree's root structure it will need to be removed.

3 replacement trees of an appropriate species are to be planted in alternative locations around the junction in new tree pits that are being installed by the scheme.
