

**CITY COUNCIL OF BRISTOL**

**(DUCIE ROAD AND THE AVENUE, LAWRENCE HILL AND ST. GEORGE WEST  
WARDS, CITY OF BRISTOL) (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) ORDER 202-**

The City Council of Bristol (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) in exercise of its powers under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended (hereinafter referred to as “the Act of 1984”) and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following order:-

Commencement and citation

1. This order shall come into operation on ----- and may be cited as the City Council of Bristol (Ducie Road and The Avenue, Lawrence Hill and St. George West Wards, City of Bristol) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 202-.

Interpretation

2. (1) In this order:-

“**dispensation letter**” means a letter issued by the Council for the purpose of this order permitting a specified vehicle (‘the permit holder’s vehicle’) to enter or proceed in the lengths of roads identified as “**Prohibition of Driving**” in the plans;

“**electronic communications apparatus**” means apparatus comprised in or to be comprised in an electronic communications network as defined in the Communications Act 2003;

“**enactment**” means any enactment whether public, general or local and includes any order, byelaw, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment;

“**motor cycle**” means a mechanically propelled vehicle (not being an invalid carriage) with fewer than 4 wheels, of which the weight unladen does not exceed 410 kilograms;

“**motor vehicle**” has the same meaning as in Section 136 of the Act of 1984;

“**pedal cycle**” means a unicycle, bicycle, tricycle or cycle having four or more wheels, not being in any case mechanically propelled unless it is an electrically assisted pedal cycle that is not treated as a motor vehicle for the purposes of the Act of 1984;

“**permit holder’s vehicle**” means a vehicle issued with a valid dispensation letter issued by the Council (subject to application as detailed in this order);

“**plans**” means the drawings which are annexed hereto as specified in the Schedule to this order;

“**police community support officer**” has the same meaning as in section 38 of the Police Reform Act 2002;

“**solo motorcycle**” means a motor cycle without a side car;

“**taxi**” means

- (i) a vehicle licensed under section 37 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 or under any similar enactment; and
- (ii) a private hire vehicle licensed as specified in Section 48 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976; and

“**traffic sign**” has the same meaning as in Section 64 of the Act of 1984.

- (2) Any reference in this order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or having affect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.

### Prohibition of Driving

3. Save as provided in Article 4 and Article 5 of this order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle other than a solo motorcycle, a taxi, or a permit holder’s vehicle to enter or proceed in the lengths of roads identified as “**Prohibition of Driving**” in the plans.

### Exemptions

4. Nothing in Article 3 of this order shall apply to any vehicle being used for fire and rescue service, ambulance or police purposes in an emergency.
5. Nothing in Article 3 of this order shall apply to any pedal cycle.

### Dispensation letters

6. (1) On receipt of an application for a specific vehicle, the Council may issue a dispensation letter and may impose such terms and conditions as it deems appropriate.  
(2) A dispensation letter may be cancelled at any time at the sole discretion of the Council and shall thereupon immediately cease to be valid. Notification of such cancellation shall be in writing.
7. The Council is satisfied that it is requisite that section 3(1) of the Act of 1984 should not apply for the following reasons:
  - (a) for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road to which the order relates or any other road, or

(b) for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising.

8. The provisions of this order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from the provisions of any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by any other enactment.

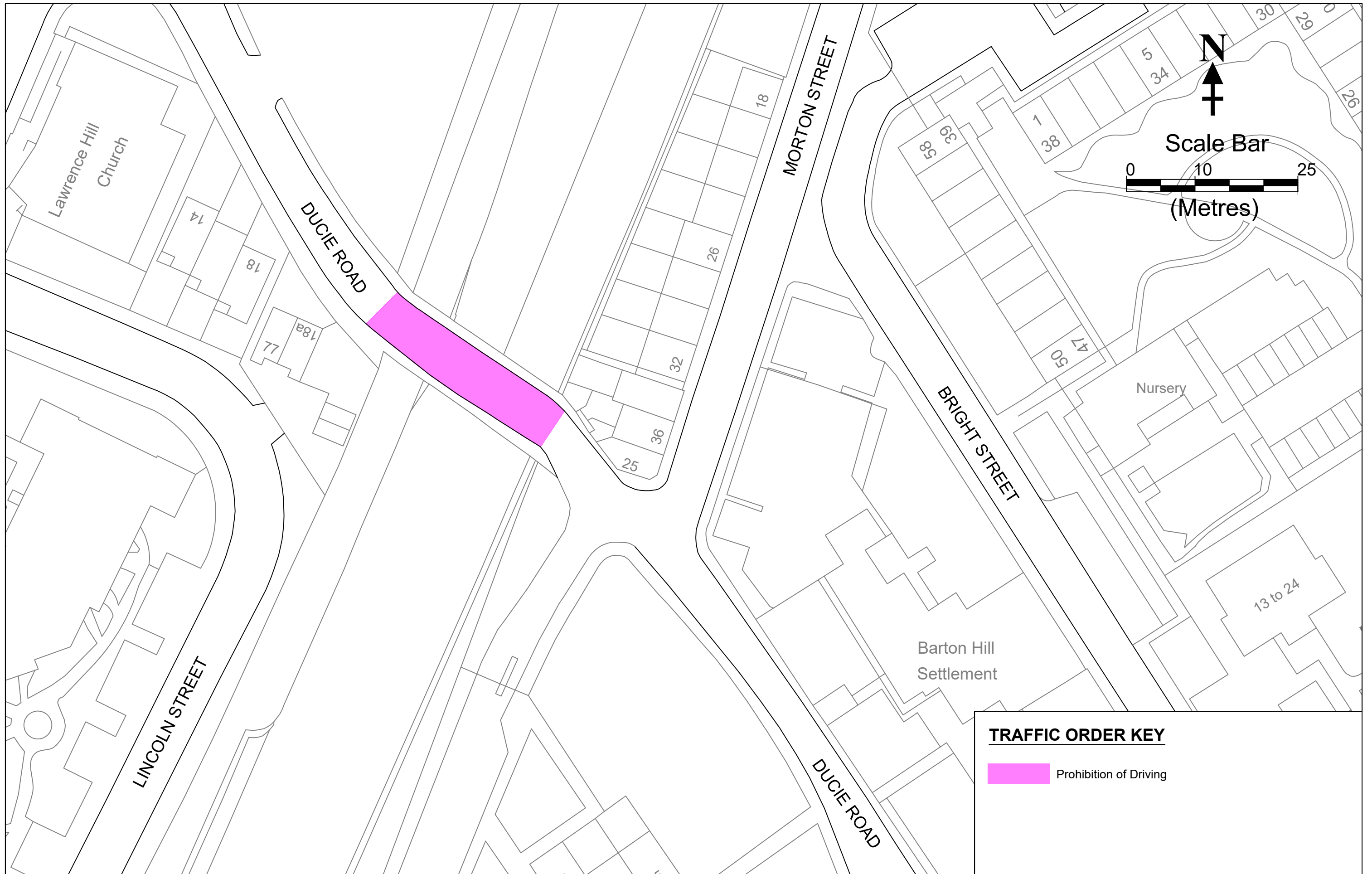
