

Fairfield High School and Rousham Road - Road Safety Scheme

Public Engagement Report

Summary of Results

A public engagement for the proposed traffic calming measures around Fairfield High School, specifically at locations on Rousham Road and Stottbury Road, took place from 9th February 2022 to 2nd March 2022. The proposed measures focused on installing speed tables which included a raised pedestrian crossing for both roads. Residents were contacted by post and the engagement was placed on our website. In total, we received 40 responses to this engagement.

Of the 40 responses received, for Location 1:

- 18 responses (45%) strongly agreed.
- 8 responses (20%) agreed.
- 6 responses (15%) were neutral.
- 4 responses (10%) disagreed.
- 4 responses (10%) strongly disagreed.

Of the 40 responses received, for Location 2:

- 12 responses (30%) strongly agreed.
- 4 responses (10%) agreed.
- 1 response (2.5%) was neutral.
- 10 responses (25%) disagreed.
- 13 responses (32.5%) strongly disagreed.

From the data, majority of the responses were in favour of the proposed layout at location 1. Whereas for location 2, the data shows that majority of the responses disagreed with the proposed layout. We have taken on board the comments made in the engagement and alterations will be made to the proposed scheme, these will include wider traffic calming measures and reduction of proposed double yellow lines.

Following this engagement, we are now proceeding with an internal technical approval. This is the stage where the designs are approved for implementation. Once the designs have been approved, we will start the legal element of the scheme. The traffic calming measures and changes to parking restrictions are all subject to a statutory consultation. This is a final opportunity for submitting objections and comments on the proposals. This page will be updated again when the statutory consultation is open. Site notices will be posted in the local area to advise stakeholders that the statutory consultation process is taking place. A notice will also be placed in the local press.
