**(ANCHOR ROAD, BRISTOL GATE, HOTWELL ROAD AND PORTWAY
(A4) – AVONMOUTH AND LAWRENCE WESTON, CLIFTON, HOTWELLS
AND HARBOURSIDE AND STOKE BISHOP WARDS, CITY OF BRISTOL)
(RESERVED BUS LANES) ORDER 202-**

The City Council of Bristol (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) in exercise of its powers under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3) and 4(1) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended (hereinafter referred to as “the Act of 1984”) and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following order:-

PART I
COMMENCEMENT, CITATION AND INTERPRETATION

Commencement and Citation

1. This order shall come into operation on [DATE] and may be cited as the City Council of Bristol (Anchor Road, Bristol Gate, Hotwell Road and Portway (A4) – Avonmouth and Lawrence Weston, Clifton, Hotwells and Harbourside and Stoke Bishop Wards, City of Bristol) (Reserved Bus Lanes) Order 202-.

Interpretation

2. (1) In this order:-

“bus” means:-

- (i) any motor vehicle constructed or adapted to carry more than 8 passengers (exclusive of the driver); and
- (ii) any local bus;

“Bus lane 1” means the area of carriageway of Portway (A4) identified as BUS LANE 1 in plan TRO-25-021P-01 annexed hereto;

“Bus Lane 2” means the area of carriageway of Portway (A4) identified as BUS LANE 2 in plan TRO-25-021P-01 annexed hereto;

“Bus Lane 3” means the area of carriageway of Portway (A4) identified as BUS LANE 3 in plan TRO-25-021P-01 annexed hereto;

“Bus Lane 4” means the area of carriageway of Portway (A4) identified as BUS LANE 4 in plan TRO-25-021P-01 annexed hereto;

“Bus Lane 5” means the area of carriageway of Portway (A4) identified as BUS LANE 5 in plans TRO-25-021P-01 and TRO-25-021P-02 annexed hereto;

“**Bus Lane 6**” means the area of carriageway of **Portway (A4)** identified as **BUS LANE 6** in plans **TRO-25-021P-01** and **TRO-25-021P-02** annexed hereto;

“**Bus Lane 7**” means the area of carriageway of **Portway (A4)** identified as **BUS LANE 7** in plan **TRO-25-021P-02** annexed hereto;

“**Bus Lane 8**” means the area of carriageway of **Portway (A4)** identified as **BUS LANE 8** in plan **TRO-25-021P-02** annexed hereto;

“**Bus Lane 9**” means the area of carriageway of **Portway (A4)** identified as **BUS LANE 9** in plans **TRO-25-021P-02** and **TRO-25-021P-03** annexed hereto;

“**Bus Lane 10**” means the area of carriageway of **Portway (A4)** identified as **BUS LANE 10** in plans **TRO-25-021P-02**, **TRO-25-021P-03** and **TRO-25-021P-04** annexed hereto;

“**Bus Lane 11**” means the area of carriageway of **Hotwell Road** identified as **BUS LANE 11** in plan **TRO-25-021P-04** annexed hereto;

“**Bus Lane 12**” means the area of carriageway of **Bristol Gate** identified as **BUS LANE 12** in plan **TRO-25-021P-04** annexed hereto;

“**Bus Lane 13**” means the area of carriageway of **Hotwell Road** identified as **BUS LANE 13** in plans **TRO-25-021P-04** and **TRO-25-021P-05** annexed hereto;

“**Bus Lane 14**” means the area of carriageway of **Hotwell Road** identified as **BUS LANE 14** in plans **TRO-25-021P-04** and **TRO-25-021P-05** annexed hereto;

“**Bus Lane 15**” means the area of carriageway of **Anchor Road** and **Hotwell Road** identified as **BUS LANE 15** in plan **TRO-25-021P-05** annexed hereto;

“**Bus Lane 16**” means the area of carriageway of **Anchor Road** identified as **BUS LANE 16** in plan **TRO-25-021P-05** annexed hereto;

“**Bus Lane 17**” means the area of carriageway of **Anchor Road** and **Canons Road** identified as **BUS LANE 17** in plan **TRO-25-021P-05** annexed hereto;

“**Bus Lane 18**” means the area of carriageway of **Anchor Road** identified as **BUS LANE 18** in plan **TRO-25-021P-05** annexed hereto;

“**carriageway**” means a way constituting or comprised in a highway, being a way over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles;

“**civil enforcement officer**” has the same meaning as in section 76 of the Traffic Management Act 2004;

“**electronic communications apparatus**” means apparatus comprised in or to be comprised in an **electronic** communications network as defined in the Communications Act 2003;

“**enactment**” means any enactment whether public, general or local and includes any order, byelaw, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment;

“**goods**” means goods of any kind whether animate or inanimate and includes postal packets of any description;

“**local bus**” means a public service vehicle used for the provision of a local service not being an excursion or tour;

“**local service**” has the same meaning as in section 2 of the Transport Act 1985;

“**motor cycle**” means a mechanically propelled vehicle (not being an invalid carriage) with fewer than 4 wheels, of which the weight unladen does not exceed 410 kilograms;

“**motor vehicle**” means a mechanically propelled vehicle intended or adapted for use on roads;

“**pedal cycle**” means a unicycle, bicycle, tricycle or cycle having four or more wheels, not being in any case mechanically propelled unless it is an electrically assisted pedal cycle that is not treated as a motor vehicle for the purposes of the Act of 1984;

“**plans**” means the drawings which are annexed hereto as specified in Schedule 1 to this order;

“**police community support officer**” has the same meaning as in section 38 of the Police Reform Act 2002;

“**postal packet**” has the same meaning as in the Postal Services Act 2000;

“**provision of a universal postal service**” has the same meaning as in the Postal Services Act 2000;

“**public service vehicle**” has the same meaning as in section 1 of the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981;

“**Regulations**” means the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016, as amended;

“**solo motorcycle**” means a motor cycle without a side car;

“**taxi**” means a vehicle licensed under section 37 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 or under any similar enactment; and

“**universal service provider**” has the same meaning as in the Postal Services Act 2000.

- (2) For the purposes of this order a vehicle shall be deemed to wait for more than two minutes in the same place if any one part of the road is below any part of the vehicle or its load (if any) throughout a period exceeding two minutes whether or not the vehicle is moved during that period.
- (3) Any reference in this order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or having affect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.

PART II **BUS LANES**

3. Save as provided in Article 6 or Article 7 of this order, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a civil enforcement officer, a police community support officer or a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle other than a bus, pedal cycle, or public service vehicle, to be in **Bus Lane 1** or **Bus Lane 2** otherwise than for the purpose of crossing it.
4. Save as provided in Article 6 or Article 7 of this order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a civil enforcement officer, a police community support officer or police constable in uniform cause or permit any vehicle other than a bus, pedal cycle, public service vehicle, solo motorcycle or taxi to be in **Bus Lane 3** or **Bus Lane 4** or **Bus Lane 5** or **Bus Lane 6** or **Bus Lane 7** or **Bus Lane 8** or **Bus Lane 9** or **Bus Lane 10** or **Bus Lane 11** or **Bus Lane 12** or **Bus Lane 13** or **Bus Lane 15** or **Bus Lane 16** or **Bus Lane 17** or **Bus Lane 18**, otherwise than for the purpose of crossing it.
5. Save as provided in Article 6 of this order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a civil enforcement officer, a police community support officer or police constable in uniform cause or permit any vehicle other than a bus, pedal cycle, public service vehicle, solo motorcycle or taxi to be in **Bus Lane 14** between the hours of 7.00 a.m. to 10.00 a.m. and 4.00 p.m. to 6.30 p.m. on any day other than a Saturday or a Sunday, otherwise than for the purpose of crossing it.

Exemptions

6. (1) Nothing in Article 3 or Article 4 or Article 5 of this order shall render it unlawful for any person to cause or permit any vehicle to be in **Bus Lane 1** or **Bus Lane 3** or **Bus Lane 4** or **Bus Lane 5** or **Bus Lane 6** or **Bus Lane 8** or **Bus Lane 9** or **Bus Lane 10** or **Bus Lane 11** or **Bus Lane 12** or **Bus Lane 13** or **Bus Lane 14** or **Bus Lane 15** or **Bus Lane 16** or **Bus Lane 17** or **Bus Lane 18** by entering or proceeding in any direction so far as it is reasonably necessary to enable the vehicle to be used for any of the purposes specified in paragraph (2) of this Article, or by waiting in the said bus lane for so long as may be necessary for any of those purposes.
- (2) The purposes referred to in paragraph (1) of this Article are:-
- (i) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (ii) police, fire and rescue service or ambulance services in the exercise of their official duties;
 - (iii) the avoidance of an accident;
 - (iv) the boarding or alighting of any person -

Provided that such boarding or alighting does not cause the vehicle to wait in the same place for more than two minutes;
 - (v) in connection with building, industrial or demolition operations in or on land adjacent to the bus lane or removals from land or buildings adjacent to the bus lane, where the prior written consent of the Council has been received;
 - (vi) in the service of any local authority, the Environment Agency, a water undertaker or sewerage undertaker in pursuance of statutory powers or duties or in connection with the supply of gas or electricity or any electronic communications apparatus as defined in the Communications Act 2003;
 - (vii) the gaining of access to or egress from off-street loading or garaging premises, or a vehicular access, which is adjacent to or accessible only from the bus lane;
 - (viii) the gaining of access to a side road where such access is only possible from within **Bus Lane 3** or **Bus Lane 5** or **Bus Lane 6** or **Bus Lane 9** or **Bus Lane 10** or **Bus Lane 13** or **Bus Lane 14** or **Bus Lane 15** or **Bus Lane 17** or **Bus Lane 18** provided that vehicle does not enter the aforesaid bus lanes by crossing road marking Diagram 1049A as provided for at item 11 of the sign table in Part 6 of Schedule 9 to the Regulations;

- (vix) to enable the loading or unloading of any goods or burden at premises adjacent to or accessible only from **Bus Lane 1** or **Bus Lane 3** or **Bus Lane 4** or **Bus Lane 5** or **Bus Lane 6** or **Bus Lane 8** or **Bus Lane 9** or **Bus Lane 10** or **Bus Lane 11** or **Bus Lane 12** or **Bus Lane 13** - **Provided** that such loading or unloading can reasonably be carried out only from the bus lane **except** where loading and unloading is prohibited at all times in any of those areas of carriageway by virtue of an order duly made under the Act of 1984.
- (x) to enable the loading or unloading of any goods or burden at premises adjacent to or accessible only from **Bus Lane 13** or **Bus Lane 15** or **Bus Lane 16** or **Bus Lane 17** or **Bus Lane 18** except where loading or unloading is restricted in any of those areas of carriageway between the hours of 7.00 a.m. to 10.00 a.m. or between the hours of 4.00 p.m. to 6.30 p.m. on any day other than a Saturday or a Sunday by virtue of an order made by the Council under the Act of 1984 and provided that such loading or unloading can reasonably be carried out only from the aforesaid bus lane.

- 7. (1) Nothing in Article 3 or Article 4 of this order shall render it unlawful for any person to cause or permit any vehicle to be in **Bus Lane 2** or **Bus Lane 7** by entering or proceeding in any direction so far as it is reasonably necessary to enable the vehicle to be used for any of the purposes specified in paragraph (2) of this Article, or by waiting in the said bus lane for so long as may be necessary for any of those purposes.
- (2) The purposes referred to in paragraph (1) of this Article are:-
 - (i) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (ii) police, fire and rescue service or ambulance services in the exercise of their official duties;
 - (iii) the avoidance of an accident; and
 - (iv) in the service of any local authority, the Environment Agency, a water undertaker or sewerage undertaker in pursuance of statutory powers or duties or in connection with the supply of gas or electricity or any electronic communications apparatus as defined in the Communications Act 2003;

PART III
VARIATION AND REVOCATION OF ORDERS

8. The City Council of Bristol (Various Roads, Bristol Bridge Area, Central & Hotwells & Harbourside Wards, City of Bristol) (Reserved Bus Lanes) (Revocation of One Way Traffic, Bus Lanes and Prohibited Movements) Order 2021 is hereby varied and shall have effect as though:-
- (a) in sub-paragraph (1) of Article 2 thereof the meaning of “bus lane 1” therein were omitted;
 - (b) Article 3 and Article 6 thereof were omitted; and
 - (c) the plan numbered E20014-TRO2-D annexed thereto were omitted.
9. The orders specified in Schedule 2 to this order are hereby revoked.
10. In so far as any provision of this order conflicts with any provision of any order made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 and which imposes a restriction or prohibition on waiting by vehicles or grants an exemption from such restriction then that provision of this order shall prevail.
