CITY COUNCIL OF BRISTOL DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT
MODIFICATION ORDER (NO. 7) 2024**

The above Order made on 10 December 2024, if confirmed as made, will modify the definitive map and statement for the area by adding to them:

A footpath (No.678) in Stoke Bishop running from grid reference 356112 176316 at Parys Lane on the field boundary of Stoke Lodge playing fields, in a generally north-westerly direction to grid reference 355929 176573, north-east of Stoke Lodge, at a junction with footpath nos.682, 683, and 684, being a total distance of approx. 317m with a minimum width of 2m

A footpath (No.679) in Stoke Bishop running from grid reference 355872 176421 at Shirehampton Road, in a generally north-westerly direction for approx. 53m to grid reference 355828 176443, then in a generally north-easterly direction for approx. 94m to grid reference 355874 176523, north-west of Stoke Lodge at a junction with footpath nos.682 and 685, being a total distance of 147m with a minimum width of 2m

A footpath (No.680) in Stoke Bishop running from grid reference 355739 176753 at the north-eastern end of Stoke Paddock Road in a generally south-easterly direction following Cheyne Road to grid reference 355792 176724, at a junction with footpath nos.683, 685 and 686 on the field boundary of Stoke Lodge playing fields on Cheyne Road, being a total distance of approx. 64m with a minimum width of approx. 2m

A footpath (No.681) in Stoke Bishop running from grid reference 356007 176607 at a junction with footpath no 87, in a generally south-westerly direction to grid reference 355993 175685 at a junction with footpath nos.684 and 686 on West Dene, being a total distance of approx. 26m with a minimum width of 2m

A footpath (No.682) in Stoke Bishop running from grid reference 355929 176573 north-east of Stoke Lodge at a junction with footpath nos.678, 683 and 684, in a generally south-westerly direction to grid reference 355874 176523, north west of Stoke Lodge at a junction with footpath nos.679 and 685, being a total distance of approx. 81m with a minimum width of 2m

A footpath (No.683) in Stoke Bishop running from grid reference 355929 176573 north-east of Stoke Lodge at a junction with footpath nos.678, 682 and 684, in a generally north-westerly direction to grid reference 355792 176724 at a junction with footpath nos.680, 685 and 686 at the field boundary of Stoke Lodge playing fields on Cheyne Road, being a total distance of approx. 204m with a minimum width of 2m

A footpath (No.684) in Stoke Bishop running from grid reference 355929 176573 north-east of Stoke Lodge at a junction with footpath nos.678, 682 and 683, in a generally east-north-easterly direction to grid reference 355993 176585 at a junction with footpath nos.681 and 686 on West Dene, being a total distance of approx. 65m with a minimum width of 2m

A footpath (No.685) in Stoke Bishop running from grid reference 355874 176523 north-west of Stoke Lodge at a junction with footpath nos.679 and 682, in a generally north-westerly direction to grid reference 355792 176724 at a junction with footpath nos.680, 683 and 686 on the field boundary of Stoke Lodge playing fields on Cheyne Road, being a total distance of approx. 217m with a minimum width of 2m

A footpath (No.686) in Stoke Bishop running from grid reference 355993 176585 at a junction with footpath nos.681 and 684 on West Dene, in a generally north-westerly direction to grid reference 355792 176724 at a junction with footpath nos.680, 683 and 685 on the field boundary of Stoke Lodge playing fields on Cheyne Road, being a total distance of approx. 244m with a minimum width of 2m as shown on the Order map accompanying the Order.

Any representation or objection relating to the Order must be sent in writing to the Service Director, Legal and Democratic Services, City Hall, PO Box 3399, Bristol BS1 9NE, quoting reference DB3/7398116 not later than 10 February 2025, and applicants are requested to state the grounds on which it is made.

If no representations or objections are duly made to the Order, or to any part of it, or if any so made are withdrawn, Bristol City Council, instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State (or part of it if the authority has by notice to the Secretary of State so elected under paragraph 5 of Schedule 15 to the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981) may itself confirm the Order (or that part of the Order). If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State, in whole or in part, any representations or objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent with it.

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980
WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981
PUBLIC FOOTPATH NO. BCC/209A & BCC/209B, BRISTOL
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION AND DEFINITIVE MAP AND
STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER (NO.5) 2024**

The above named order, made on the 10 December 2024 under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 will divert:

- the public footpath running from grid reference 360040 175674 in a northerly direction for 12m to grid reference 360041 175685, then running for a distance of 40m to grid reference 360034 175723, with a width of approx. 2 metres along its entire length; to a line running from said grid reference 360040 175674 in a generally northerly and north-easterly direction for a distance of approx. 55m to grid reference 360044 175723, being the junction with FP 211, with a minimum width of approx. 3.8m along its entire length; and
- the public footpath running from grid reference 360041 175685 in a north-westerly direction for approx. 35m to grid reference 360021 175713, with a width of approximately 2m along its entire length; to a line running from said grid reference 360040 175674 in a generally northerly and north-westerly direction for a distance of approx. 52m to grid reference 360020 175717, on Station Road, with a minimum width of approx. 3.8m along its entire length

as shown on the order map accompanying the order.

The order is also made under Section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 (the 1981 Act) because it appears to the authority that the City Council of Bristol definitive map and statement require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(a)(i) of the 1981 Act, namely the diversion of a highway shown or required to be shown in the map and statement.

Please state the grounds on which they are made.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, Bristol City Council may confirm the order as an unopposed order. If the order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment Food and Rural Affairs for confirmation any representations or objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the order.


