

## **Allocation Statement for Glenfrome Primary School - September 2026**

As Glenfrome Primary School was oversubscribed, the criteria stated in their published admissions policy available on the school and Local Authority websites have been applied to allocate the places that are available at the school.

147 on-time applications (58 x 1<sup>st</sup> preferences, 51 x 2<sup>nd</sup> preferences, 38 x 3<sup>rd</sup> preferences) have been received for Glenfrome Primary School, which has an Admission Number of 60.

### **How the Initial Allocation of Places was made**

1 place was required by the SEN Team for a pupil where Education Health and Care Plans named Glenfrome Primary School.

The remaining 59 places have been offered to the following children:

1. Children in the care of the Local Authority or who were previously in Care but immediately after being in Care became subject to an adoption order, child arrangement order or special guardianship order. (1 place)
2. Those children with siblings already at Glenfrome Primary School and who will still be there in September 2026. (24 places)
3. Those children living closest to Glenfrome Primary School as measured in a direct line from the home address to the school. (34 places) The furthest distance offered a place in this category was 1.869 km.

### **Infant class size prejudice appeals - effects of infant Class Size legislation.**

Appeals for Glenfrome Primary School will be heard based on infant class size prejudice as the school will have two Reception classes each containing 30 pupils.

## **Second Round Allocation**

As of 18<sup>th</sup> May 2026, 3 places became available for reallocation. At this point there were 6 pupils on the Waiting List. The final date to make an application or changes to an application for the second round of allocations was 8 May 2026. The school's published admissions criteria was applied and the place offered to the following pupils:

1. Children in the care of the Local Authority or who were previously in Care but immediately after being in Care became subject to an adoption order, child arrangement order or special guardianship order. (0 places)
2. Those children with siblings already at Glenfrome Primary School and who will still be there in September 2026. (3 places)

The furthest distance offered a place in this category was 1.728 km
