

First Round Allocation Statement for Stoke Bishop CofE Primary School - September 2026

As Stoke Bishop CofE Primary School was oversubscribed, the criteria stated in their published admissions policy available on the school and Local Authority websites have been applied to allocate the places that are available at the school.

129 on-time applications (48 x 1st preferences, 48 x 2nd preferences, 33 x 3rd preferences) have been received for Stoke Bishop CofE Primary School, which has an Admission Number of 60).

How the Initial Allocation of Places was made

2 places are required for children with the school named in their Education, Health and Care Plan.

The remaining 58 places have been offered to the following children:

1. Children in the care of the Local Authority or who were previously in Care but immediately after being in Care became subject to an adoption order, child arrangement order or special guardianship order. (3 places)
2. Those children with siblings already at Stoke Bishop CofE Primary School and who will still be there in September 2026. (22 places)
3. Those children living closest to Stoke Bishop CofE Primary School as measured in a direct line from the home address to the school. (33 places) The furthest distance offered a place in this category was 3.124 km.

Second Round Allocation Statement for Stoke Bishop CofE Primary School – September 2026

As of 18 May 2026, 2 places became available for reallocation. At this point there were 3 applicants on the waiting list. The final date to make an application or changes to an application for the second round of allocations was 8 May 2026.

The school's published admissions criteria was applied and the places were offered to the following pupils:

1. Children in the care of the Local Authority or who were previously in Care but immediately after being in Care became subject to an adoption order, child arrangement order or special guardianship order. (0 places)
2. Those children with siblings already at Stoke Bishop CofE Primary School and who will still be there in September 2026. (0 places)
3. Those children living closest to Stoke Bishop CofE Primary School as measured in a direct line from the home address to the school. (2 places) The furthest distance offered a place in this category was 3.163km.

Infant class size prejudice appeals - effects of infant class size legislation.

Appeals for Stoke Bishop CofE Primary School will be heard based on infant class size prejudice as the school will have two Reception classes each containing 30 pupils.
