**(COOMBE ROAD, EAST PARK AND FREELAND BUILDINGS, EASTVILLE  
WARD, CITY OF BRISTOL) (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) (ONE WAY TRAFFIC)  
ORDER 202-**

The City Council of Bristol hereby gives NOTICE that it proposes to make a traffic order, the effect of which would be:-

1. to prohibit any vehicle from entering or proceeding in **Coombe Road** and **East Park** between the hours of 8.25 a.m. and 9.10 a.m. and the hours of 3.05 p.m. and 3.55 p.m. on Monday to Friday. The closure would operate during May Park Primary School term days only and exemption would be provided for pedal cycles, blue badge holders, for specified/statutory purposes and for permit holders. Permits would be issued at the discretion of the Council; and
2. to extend the existing south westbound one way traffic in **East Park** to its junction with East Park Drive.

Note: the existing one way traffic in Coombe Road and Freeland Buildings would be brought forward into the new order unchanged.
