On 5 May 2026 the court re-considered an application for an injunction

The Court ordered that

TO ALL PERSONS UNKNOWN:

1. WHO ARE RESIDING, OR INTENDING TO RESIDE, IN TENTS, CARAVANS, VANS, OR ANY OTHER VEHICLES OR STRUCTURES ADAPTED FOR RESIDENTIAL OR LIVING PURPOSES;

AND

2. WHO ARE PRESENT ON CLIFTON DOWN, DURDHAM DOWN LADIES MILE, PARRYS LANE, SAVILLE ROAD, DOWNLEAZE, ROCKLEAZE, CIRCULAR ROAD, ROMAN ROAD, CLAY PIT ROAD, STOKE ROAD, WILLS LANE, OR WESTBURY PARK

is forbidden (whether by himself or by instructing or encouraging any other person) **FROM:**

1. Entering or being present, within any of the areas shown in the Map attached to this injunction edged and hatched red or green, with the intention to reside or live in any tent, caravan, van, or any other vehicle or structure adapted for residential or living purposes.

2. Entering or being present on the roads marked in blue shown in the Map attached to this injunction with the intention to reside or live in any tent, caravan, van, or any other vehicle or structure adapted for residential or living purposes.

3. Defecating and/or urinating, other than in the public toilets, within any of the areas shown in the Map attached to this injunction edged and hatched red or green, or on the roads marked in blue.

4. Placing household or any other waste material within any of the areas shown in the Map attached to this injunction edged and hatched red or green, or on the roads marked in blue. For the avoidance of doubt, this prohibits the use of the public bins.

5. In relation to the areas shown in the Map attached to this injunction edged and hatched red or green, causing any nuisance, harassment, alarm or distress to any person lawfully present on the areas shown in the Map attached to this injunction edged and hatched red or green, or the roads marked in blue, by way of any or all of:

a dangerous driving of any vehicle;

b verbal or physical abuse or threats;

c unreasonable levels of noise;

d allowing any animal to be out of control; or

e disposing of waste except in a manner expressly permitted in writing by Bristol City Council.

AND IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT:

6. You must vacate any of the areas shown in the Map attached to this injunction edged and hatched red or green, or the roads marked in blue, within two hours of any written or oral request by an authorised officer or agent of Bristol City Council or by any constable (provided that at the time of the request you are offered a copy of this injunction) and you must not return to the said area without the express written permission of Bristol City Council.

7. A power of arrest is attached to clauses 1, 3 4 and 5 of this Injunction Order pursuant to section 4 of Anti-social Behaviour Crime & Policing Act 2014. Any constable may arrest any person to whom this injunction applies without a warrant if they have reasonable cause for suspecting a breach any of the above provisions.

8. This Order shall remain in force until 11:59pm on 5 May 2027 unless before then it is revoked or varied by a further Order of the Court.

9. The Court will review the matter on 17 September 2026 at 10.00 am, for 30 minutes at Bristol Civil Justice Centre, Redcliff Street, Bristol, BS1 6GR.

10. **Your attention is drawn to your right to apply to the Court to set aside or vary this injunction.** Any application must be made to the County Court at Bristol at the Bristol Civil Justice Centre, 2 Redcliff Street, Bristol, BS1 6GR or by email to e-filing.bristol.countycourt@justice.gov.uk.

Your application must be made on HMCTS Form N244 or by way of letter provided it is signed with a statement of truth and a copy must be sent to legal.support@bristol.gov.uk at the same time it is filed with the Court. A hearing will then be arranged with no less than two clear days' notice to all parties, or shorter if the parties agree or the Court orders otherwise.

You must comply with this order pending any hearing.

This order shall remain in force until 5 May 2027 at 11:59 PM unless before then it is revoked by further order of the court

Notice of further hearing

The court will reconsider the application and whether the order should continue at a further hearing at the County Court at Bristol, Bristol Civil Justice Centre, Number 2, Redcliff Street, Bristol, BS1 6GR on 17 September 2026 at 10:00 AM, **time estimate 30 minutes. PARTIES ARE REQUIRED TO ATTEND**

If you do not attend at the time shown the court may make an injunction order in your absence.

You are entitled to apply to the court to reconsider the order before the day.

The court is satisfied that the conduct which is prohibited by this injunction, consists of or includes the use or threatened use of violence and there is a significant risk of harm to a person towards whom the conduct prohibited by this injunction is directed.

A power of arrest is attached to terms paragraph 1, 3, 4 and 5 of this injunction whereby any constable may under the power given in section 9 of the Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014, arrest without warrant

the defendant if the constable has reasonable cause for suspecting the defendant is in breach of any of those terms of this injunction.

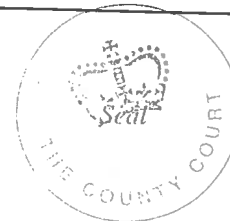

That the conditions in sections 4 of the Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014, are satisfied,

That the conduct consists of or includes use of violence.

A power of arrest is attached to this injunction whereby any constable may under the power given in section 9 of the Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014, arrest without warrant the defendant if the constable has reasonable cause for the suspecting the defendant is in breach of this injunction.

This power of arrest was ordered on 5 May 2026 and expires on 5 May 2027 at 23.59 hours or further order.

Note to Arresting Officer

Where the defendant is arrested under the power given by section 155 of the Housing Act 1996, or section 27 of the Police and Justice Act 2006; or section 43 of the Policing and Crime Act 2009; or section 4 of the Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014:

- the defendant shall be brought before the judge within the period of 24 hours beginning at the time of their arrest;
- a constable shall inform the person on whose application the injunction was granted, forthwith where the defendant is arrested under the power given by section 155 of the Housing Act 1996 or as soon as reasonably practicable where the defendant is arrested under the power given by section 27 of the Police and Justice Act 2006 or section 43 of the Policing and Crime Act 2009 or section 9 of the Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014.

Nothing in section 155 of the Housing Act 1996 or section 27 of the Police and Justice Act 2006 or section 43 of the Policing and Crime Act 2009 or section 4 of the Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014, shall authorise the detention of the respondent after the expiry of the period of 24 hours beginning at the time of their arrest.

In calculating any period of 24 hours, no account shall be taken of Christmas Day, Good Friday or any Sunday.
