

CITY COUNCIL OF BRISTOL

(CAVENDISH STREET, ELMTREE ROAD AND RALEIGH ROAD, BEDMINSTER AND SOUTHVILLE WARDS, CITY OF BRISTOL) (PROHIBITION OF LEFT TURN) (PROHIBITION OF ENTRY) ORDER 202-

The City Council of Bristol (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) in exercise of its powers under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended (hereinafter referred to as “the Act of 1984”) and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following order:-

Commencement and citation

1. This order shall come into operation on ----- and may be cited as the City Council of Bristol (Cavendish Street, Elmtree Road and Raleigh Road, Bedminster and Southville Wards, City of Bristol) (Prohibition of Left Turn) (Prohibition of Entry) Order 202-.

Interpretation

2. (1) In this order “enactment” means any enactment whether public, general or local and includes any order, byelaw, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment.
- (2) Any reference in this order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.

Prohibition of Left Turn

3. Save as provided in Article 5 of this order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to make a left turn movement in relation to the roads at the locations where this is illustrated as “**Prohibited Left Turn**” in plan **RPS-SE26-PLT** annexed hereto.

Prohibition of Entry

4. Save as provided in Article 5 of this order no person shall cause or permit any proceeding vehicle to enter any road from the side illustrated in plan **RPS-SE26-PLT** annexed hereto at any location where this is illustrated as “**Prohibition of Entry**” in plan **RPS-SE26-PLT** annexed hereto.

Exemption

5. Nothing in Article 3 or Article 4 of this order shall apply to any vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue service or ambulance purposes in an emergency.
6. The provisions of this order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from the provisions of any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by any other enactment.
