## **ACT 1984**

### **SECTION 23 PEDESTRIAN CROSSING**



NOTICE is hereby given that the City Council of Bristol in exercise of powers conferred by section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, and after consultation with the chief officer of police, intends to:-

1. **remove** the following push button controlled (pelican) crossing in the City of Bristol:
