(PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 202-

The City Council of Bristol hereby gives NOTICE that it proposes to make a traffic order, the effect of which would be:-

1. to introduce prohibition of waiting arrangements for vehicles in lengths of **Connaught Road, Exmouth Road and Ilminster Avenue**; and
2. to revise prohibition of waiting arrangements for vehicles in lengths of **Broad Walk, Daventry Road, Minehead Road, Newquay Road, Tavistock Road and Teignmouth Road**.
