Map with road names (true north)

Coombe Lane (via West Dene):
Bus stops into city centre/out to Cribbs Causeway.
Routes via public footpaths to Canford Park, Canford Cemetery, allotments, Stoke Lane and Westbury on Trym.

Stoke Lane: route to Black Swan ('Dirty Duck') and Prince of Wales pubs, Westbury on Trym and library.
Stoke Lane shops.

Cheyne Road:
Routes via public footpaths to Sea Mills, Trym Valley and Blaise Castle estate (Bristol Greenwalk)

Shirehampton Road:
Bus stops into City centre/out to Cribbs Causeway.
