The Council of the City and County of Bristol, as local planning authority, make this Direction in exercise of their powers under Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1963, and of all other enabling powers:

1. The Council hereby direct that the permission granted by Article 3 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1963 shall not apply to any development of Class I or Class II(1) specified in Part I of Schedule 1 to the said Order within the areas edged red on the plan annexed to this Direction which are preservation areas in the Henbury Conservation Area in the City of Bristol (which has been designated for the purpose of Section 1 of the Civic Amenities Act 1967).
2. This Direction may be cited as "The City and County of Bristol (Henbury) Direction, 1971."

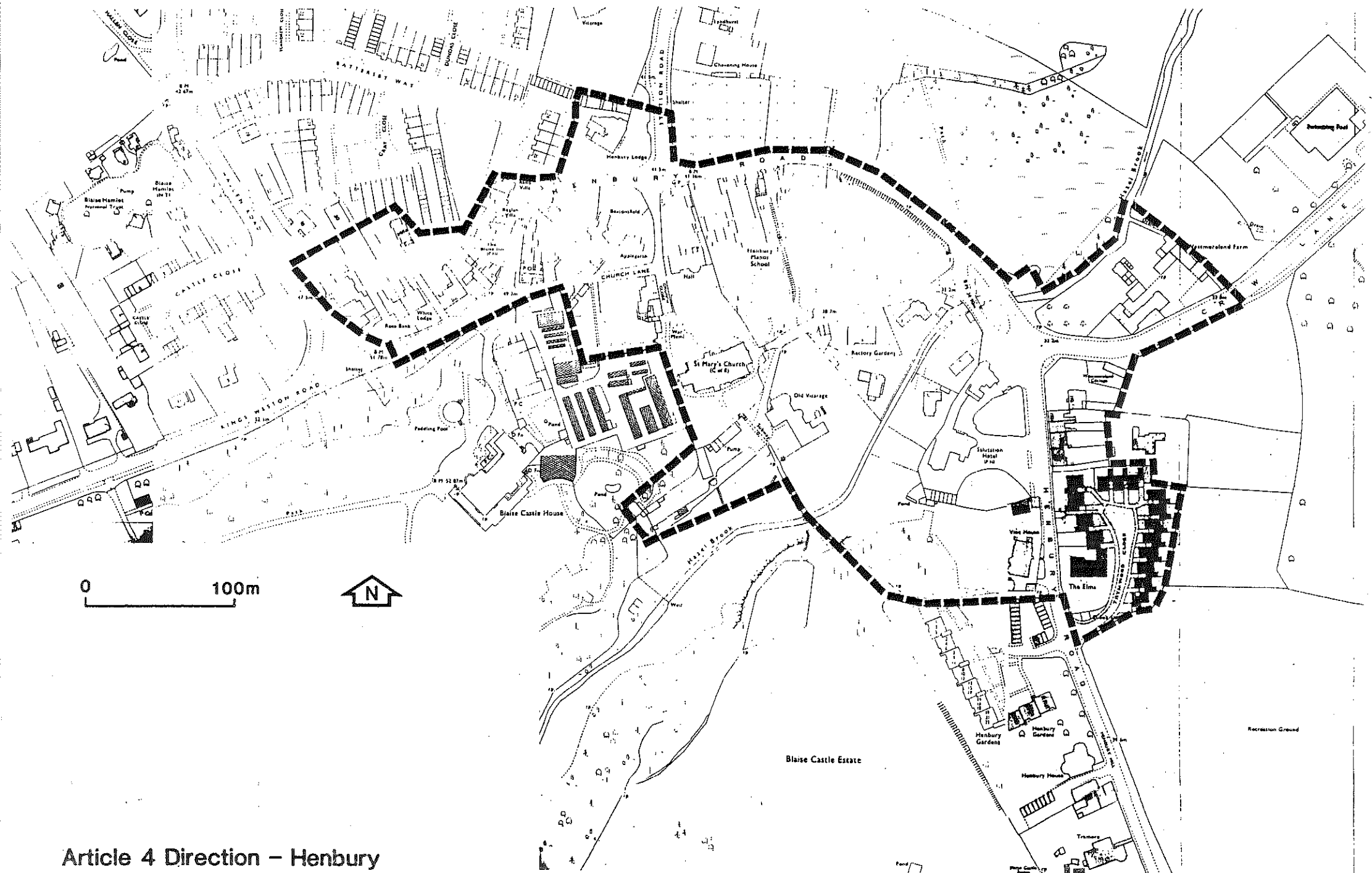
