Your personal data may be shared with other teams within the Council in order to provide a service to you, to ensure our records are kept up to date, to determine entitlement to Local Crisis and Prevention Fund or otherwise where we are required to do so under other legislation. We may also share it with other government bodies such as the Department for Work and Pensions (DWP) and HM Revenues and Customs (HMRC) and local authorities if necessary in order to correctly administer your claim. We may share the data with third parties if we are required by law to do so, this may include the Police or Government Agencies. We will not sell your data or use it for marketing purposes without your consent.

We will keep your personal data for as long as we are required to do so under relevant legislation or in accordance with our operational requirements.

We may have obtained your data from a third party, such as DWP, HMRC, the Council's Benefit Service or other relevant departments or a support worker.
