- (e) customer profile;
- (f) seasonal trading patterns; and
- (g) any relevant crime and disorder considerations or intelligence.

The Applicant proposes that the existing condition - "DC02 There shall be a minimum of two door supervisors, who have been accredited by the Security Industry Authority or any accreditation scheme recognition by the Licensing Authority on duty from 19:00 hours on each Friday, Saturday and every Sunday before a Bank Holiday Monday with an additional two door supervisors on duty from 21:00 hours and who shall remain on duty until 02:00." be replaced with the following wording;  
"The requirement for door supervisors shall be determined by the Designated Premises Supervisor or duty manager on the basis of a documented daily risk assessment, having regard to the nature of the event, anticipated occupancy levels, operating hours, entertainment provided, customer profile and any relevant crime and disorder considerations. Where the risk assessment identifies a need for door supervisors, SIA registered door supervisors shall be employed in such numbers as are appropriate to the risk identified."
