


Positive trends:

- Citizen engagement was driven this month by campaigns and partnerships including #BristolDigitalFuturesInstitute, Future Quest, #BristolReadingCity and the BITC waste summit
- Strong pick of the Mayor's comments on migration and the Mayors Migration Council, driven by sharing of news pieces via BBC and NowThisNews
- Cut through for the Mayor's announcement that 435 councils will back Bristol's pledge to deliver the UN's SDGs and declare a climate emergency
- The Mayor's advocacy for the One City Plan initiative continues to drive a positive discussion about the future of Bristol
- Strong positive response to the launch of the #wearebristol campaign
- The new proposal for Temple Island including the L&G deal provided some positive awareness around new jobs and homes
- Posts from VisitBristol got people talking about the city as a 'great destination'
- The announcement of new charging points for electric vehicles
- A post from interviewing MR as one of a group of global mayors on the challenges their cities face


Negative trends:

- Negative discussion around air quality was linked to the perception that BCC favours car transport over other modes, the airport expansion and personal anecdotes/accounts of pollution in the city
- continue to drive a negative narrative about the arena project although there are no new arguments within this discussion
- Avonmouth continues to be regularly cited as suffering from poor environmental controls and high levels of pollution
- Fragmented complaints about "wasted millions" and "out of control" spending linked to Freedom of Information requests
- Some negativity around housing projects (Lawrence Hill) and the impact the L&G Temple Island deal will have on affordable housing. The stat that 12,000 families remain on the Council's housing list is being used against the Mayor and BCC
- Persistent accusations that the Mayor is more interested in 'cosying up to' big corporations and the private sector than putting the needs of Bristolians first
- Most complaints about bus services this month were directed at FirstBus due to fare increases
- Sharing of a story from Disability News which reported that a UN human rights expert was told that disabled asylum-seekers in Bristol have been evicted by social services


