Old Market is wide enough to have segregated cycle lanes, so why not include this in the plans now, rather than spending money to decrease the width of the street and then in a couple of years digging it all up again to put in the segregated cycle lanes that everyone will be demanding.

I also agree the crossing points should be segregated, its horrible as a pedestrian to have cyclist coming towards you when crossing roads and as for shared space, forget it that is early 2000 thinking on cycle plans.
