- 4. The £500 deposit can be paid by (a) the deposit of any legal tender or by (b) means of a banker's draft or by (c) electronic transfer of funds using a debit card.
- 5. If the election is contested the poll will take place on Thursday 12 December 2019.
- 6. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at 5th Floor, B Bond, Smeaton Road, Bristol, BS1 6XN by 12 midnight on Tuesday 26 November 2019.
- Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes and amendments or cancellations of proxy votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at 5th Floor, B Bond, Smeaton Road, Bristol, BS1 6XN by 5 pm on Tuesday 26 November 2019.
- 8. New applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at 5th Floor, B Bond, Smeaton Road, Bristol, BS1 6XN by 5 pm on Wednesday 4 December 2019.
- 9. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at 5th Floor, B Bond, Smeaton Road, Bristol, BS1 6XN by 5 pm on Thursday 12 December 2019. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5 pm on Wednesday 4 December 2019. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5 pm on Wednesday 4 December 2019.
