September 2021 first round allocation statement for Oasis Academy John Williams

As Oasis Academy John Williams was oversubscribed, the admissions criteria published on the Academy and Local Authority websites have been applied to allocate the places that are available at the Academy.

Number of applications received

467 on-time applications (211 first preferences, 165 second preferences and 91 third preferences) have been received for Oasis Academy John Williams which has a published admission number of 162. The Academy has breached the admission number for Year 7 in 2021 to 180.

2 places were required for children with the school named in their Education, Health and Care Plan.

This left 178 places to allocate using the published criteria.

How the initial allocation of places was made

The 178 places have been offered to the following children:

- 1. Those children who are defined as Children in Care or children who were previously in care but immediately after being in care became subject to an adoption, child arrangements or special guardianship order. (3 places)
- Those children with siblings who will be members of years 7 to 11 at the Academy on the date when the applicant would be admitted. The term sibling means full, step, half, adopted or fostered brother or sister, or other child living permanently within the same household. The Academy reserves the right to ask for proof of relationship. (58 places)
- 3. Those children who live within the area of first priority for Oasis Academy John Williams, who live closest to the Academy as measured in a direct line from the home address to the school. (109 places)
- 4. Those children living outside the area of first priority for Oasis Academy John Williams who live closest to the Academy as measured in a direct line from the home address to the Academy. (8 places) The furthest distance offered a place under these criteria was 1.076 km.

Second Round Allocation

As at 9th April 2021 no places had become available for reallocation at Oasis Academy John Williams. At this stage there were 51 applicants waiting for a place at the Academy.
