Allocation Statement for Oasis Academy Marksbury Road - September 2021

As Oasis Academy Marksbury Road was oversubscribed, the criteria stated in their published admissions policy available on the Academy and Local Authority websites have been applied to allocate the places that are available at the Academy.

183 on-time applications (53 x 1^{st} preferences, 62 x 2^{nd} preferences, 68 x 3^{rd} preferences have been received for Oasis Academy Marksbury Road, which has an Admission Number of 60.

How the Initial Allocation of Places was made

The 60 places have been offered to the following children:

- 1. Children in the care of the Local Authority or who were previously in Care but immediately after being in Care became subject to an adoption order, child arrangement order or special guardianship order. (1 place)
- 2. Those children with siblings already at Oasis Academy Marksbury Road and who will still be there in September 2021. (25 places)
- 3. Those children living closest to Oasis Academy Marksbury Road as measured in a direct line from the home address to the Academy. (34 places) The furthest distance offered a place in this category was 0.852 km.

Infant class size prejudice appeals - effects of infant class size legislation.

Appeals for Oasis Academy Marksbury Road will be heard on the basis of infant class size prejudice as the Academy will have two Reception classes each containing 30 pupils.
