

Allocation Statement for St Mary Redcliffe Church of England Primary Academy - September 2021

As St Mary Redcliffe Church of England Primary Academy was oversubscribed, the criteria stated in their published admissions policy available on the Academy and Local Authority websites have been applied to allocate the places that are available at the Academy.

149 on-time applications (54 x 1st preferences, 47 x 2nd preferences, 48 x 3rd preferences) have been received for St Mary Redcliffe Church of England Primary Academy, which has an Admission Number of 60.

How the Initial Allocation of Places was made

The 60 places have been offered to the following children:

1. Children in the care of the Local Authority or who were previously in Care but immediately after being in Care became subject to an adoption order, child arrangement order or special guardianship order. (0 places)
2. Those children with siblings already at St Mary Redcliffe Church of England Primary Academy and who will still be there in September 2021. (22 places)
3. Those children living closest to St Mary Redcliffe Church of England Primary Academy as measured in a direct line from the home address to the Academy. (38 places)

The furthest distance offered a place in this category was 0.764 km.

2nd Round Allocation

As at 17th May 2021 3 places became available at the Academy for reallocation. There were 14 wanting to be considered.

The 3 places have been offered to the following children:

1. Children in the care of the Local Authority or who were previously in Care but immediately after being in Care became subject to an adoption order, child arrangement order or special guardianship order. (0 places)
2. Those children with siblings already at St Mary Redcliffe Church of England Primary Academy and who will still be there in September 2021. (0 places)
3. Those children living closest to St Mary Redcliffe Church of England Primary Academy as measured in a direct line from the home address to the Academy. (3 places)

The furthest distance offered a place in this category was 0.543 km.

Infant class size prejudice appeals - effects of infant class Size legislation.

Appeals for St Mary Redcliffe Church of England Primary Academy will be heard on the basis of infant class size prejudice as the Academy will have two Reception classes each containing 30 pupils.
