Allocation Statement for Glenfrome Primary School -September 2021

As Glenfrome Primary School was oversubscribed, the criteria stated in their published admissions policy available on the school and Local Authority websites have been applied to allocate the places that are available at the school.

166 on-time applications (77 x 1^{st} preferences, 52 x 2^{nd} preferences, 37 x 3^{rd} preferences have been received for Glenfrome Primary School, which has an Admission Number of 60.

2 places were required for pupils with Education Health and Care Plans which name Glenfrome Primary School

How the Initial Allocation of Places was made

The remaining 58 places have been offered to the following children:

- 1. Children in the care of the Local Authority or who were previously in Care but immediately after being in Care became subject to an adoption order, child arrangement order or special guardianship order. (5 places)
- 2. Those children with siblings already at Glenfrome Primary School and who will still be there in September 2021. (29 places)
- 3. Those children living closest to Glenfrome Primary School as measured in a direct line from the home address to the school. (24 places) The furthest distance offered a place in this category was 1.054 km.

Infant class size prejudice appeals - effects of infant Class Size legislation.

Appeals for Glenfrome Primary School will be heard on the basis of infant class size prejudice as the school will have two Reception classes each containing 30 pupils.

Guidance on infant class size prejudice appeals is available on the school admissions website.

Second Round Allocation of Places

As at 21st May 2021 1 place had become available for reallocation. As there were 20 pupils waiting for a place it was necessary to apply the school's admission criteria.

The 1 place has been offered to the following child:

2. A child with siblings already at Glenfrome Primary School and who will still be

there in September 2021. (1 place) The furthest distance offered under this category was 461m.
