Allocation Statement for Brentry Primary School - September 2021

As Brentry Primary School was oversubscribed, the criteria stated in their published admissions policy available on the school and Local Authority websites have been applied to allocate the places that are available at the school.

98 on-time applications (54 x 1^{st} preferences, 24 x 2^{nd} preferences, 20 x 3^{rd} preferences have been received for Brentry Primary School, which has an Admission Number of 30.

How the Initial Allocation of Places was made

The 30 places have been offered to the following children:

- 1. Children in the care of the Local Authority or who were previously in Care but immediately after being in Care became subject to an adoption order, child arrangement order or special guardianship order. (0 places)
- 2. Those children with siblings already at Brentry Primary School and who will still be there in September 2021. (16 places)
- 3. Those children living closest to Brentry Primary School as measured in a direct line from the home address to the school. (14 places) The furthest distance offered a place in this category was 0.531 km.

Infant class size prejudice appeals - effects of infant class Size legislation.

Appeals for Brentry Primary School will be heard on the basis of infant class size prejudice as the school will have one Reception classes containing 30 pupils.

Second Round Allocation

As at 26th May 2021 1 place had become available at Brentry Primary School. As there were 14 pupils still waiting for a place it was necessary to apply the school's published admissions criteria to determine who was offered the place.

The child living closest to Brentry Primary School as measured in a direct line from the home address to the school. The furthest distance offered a place in this category was 0.531 km.
